
#### Why tutoring?

The ongoing impact of COVID-19 to children's education has meant that schools have seen a rise in the number of pupils needing specific, personalised intervention support. In response to this demand the government created the National Tutoring Programme (NTP), to help hundreds of thousands of children to fill in the gaps in their learning.

In 2021, as an approved partner Pearson Tutoring helped over 9,000 children across England and the positive impact of that tutoring has been wonderful to witness. We're particularly proud of the quality of our tutoring and our ability to reach those most disadvantaged in some of the least well-represented regions.

#### What type of tutoring is available?


This year the Department for Education will provide ring-fenced grant funding directly to schools to support provision of school-led tutoring. The grant is calculated to cover 60% of the cost of tuition (based on average costs of tutoring) with schools contributing the remaining costs.

There are three types of subsidised tutoring under the School-led Tutoring grant:

**1. Tuition partners –** This year schools may only use approved tuition providers from the DFE list, to conduct tutoring sessions. Pearson Tutoring continues to be a quality assured approved supplier under the government funded tuition programme.

**2. School-led Tutoring** – Schools may also use their own staff to provide sessions, this can be current staff or those newly engaged for this purpose.

**3. Academic Mentors –** These will be a part of their school's staff team and will be supported and managed by the school to deliver tutoring that is appropriate, timely, and linked to their curriculum. They will receive a core salary funded by the DfE. For more information visit <u>gov.uk</u>.



### How is your funding calculated

The amount that schools will receive will be proportionate to the number of Pupil Premium students on roll.

This funding is paid in termly instalments via local authorities and academy trusts and is intended to cover 60% of the unit cost of tutoring, the remainder of the cost may be covered using pupil premium or other core school budgets.

For the 2022/2023 school year the government will provide the following funding for NTP:

- Mainstream schools receive £162 per PP-eligible pupil
- Non-mainstream schools receive £423 per PP-eligible pupil.

NTP funding can be used to pay for 60% of the total cost incurred by your school to deliver tutoring. These costs are:

- £18 for mainstream schools, of which the DfE subsidy will be £10.80 (60%)
- £47 for non-mainstream schools, of which the DfE subsidy will be £28.20 (60%)

Please note:

All state-maintained schools in England are automatically part of this scheme and will not have to apply for funding; it is not an opt-in scheme, so schools will receive the funds directly in three tranches. Please note any funding not used on catch up activities by 31st August 2023, will have to be returned to the DfE.


