BACKGROUND AND MOTIVATION

Why did you choose to pursue an apprenticeship?

I began my career as a school leaver by completing an apprenticeship in cable joinery, which provided a structured and hands-on learning environment that aligns well with my preferred learning style. I thrive in settings where I can apply practical skills alongside theoretical knowledge, and I find this approach both engaging and effective.

What specific skills did you learn during your apprenticeship?

Throughout my apprenticeship, I learned to navigate diverse working environments and collaborate effectively with colleagues and clients, which strengthened my interpersonal skills. The experience also taught me the importance of empathy, active listening, and adaptability - key components of emotional intelligence - especially when working under pressure or resolving on-site challenges.
