Design brief:

Design and make a piece of jewellery which represents you; your identify, your interests and/or your personality.

- Show the world who you are - make sure your design is original and reflects you.
- Take time to research, reflect and sketch.
- The product can be manufactured from any materials that can be cut by a laser cutter.
- It must be fit for purpose, comfortable and safe to wear.



If you don't have access to a laser cutter, don't worry – you can still show your final design clearly and professionally. One option is to present your design in the same way Tatty Devine do, by creating detailed drawings that show how your piece would be made, including manufacturing details, colours, and finishes. Take a look at the attached example to guide you.

If you'd prefer to make your jewellery by hand, you can use hand tools to cut out thin pieces of material instead. Materials like plywood or acrylic work really well for this and are easy to experiment with.

Most importantly, enjoy the process! Keep testing and refining your design as you go to make sure it's the right size and shape, and that it feels comfortable and works well when worn on the body.
