

# Register for your Pearson course

First, make sure you have these three things:

1. **Email:** If you already have access to another Pearson app, your existing username and password can be used again. If you need to set up an account, you will need a valid email address which you check regularly.
2. **Course Invite Link:** Your instructor is responsible for providing the Course Invite Link to you. You may receive an invite link via email from your instructor, on your syllabus, or through class set-up materials. It looks something like this:

3. **Access code or credit card:** You can purchase an access code where you buy your textbooks. Or you can buy instant access with a credit card or PayPal account during registration.

## Next, get registered:

1. Enter the Course Invite Link in your web browser. Please use the [recommended browsers and settings](#).
2. If you have a Pearson account, enter your username and password. Otherwise, create a new account. If you create an account, you'll need to confirm your email address from a message sent to the email you specify.
3. From your "My Courses" page, choose how you would like to access the course. Your choices include: Redeem a pre-purchased access code, buy access using a credit card or PayPal account, or choose Temporary Access if you're waiting on financial aid.

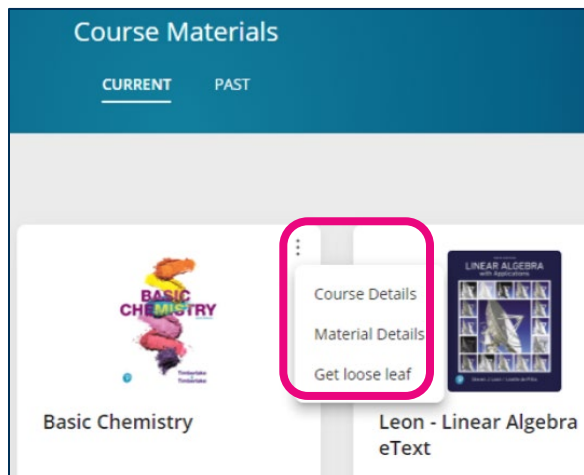
That's it! To access your Pearson course throughout the term, log in from [console.pearson.com](https://console.pearson.com).
