Dave Treat:

The ability now, in the latest generation, to be able to project, in augmented reality information on my field of vision just as, I think, the beginning of a massive wave of innovation that will have a huge impact on education.

Matthew Sanders:

Imagine being able to create basically any object to bring into the classroom in order to teach a lesson. I think it's going to be really exciting and interesting to see, what teachers do with that through Al. And then also being able to, being able to then adapt those environments and those experiences that you're creating for individual students based on what you know about them and, and how other similar students might have performed in those settings. So, really, I guess my big lesson for everyone is get involved in this technology, have a go at using it, but be ready for the fact that they're all going to start intersecting these technologies in new and powerful ways over the next few years.
