2. Logging into MyLab





- Once logged in, return to top-right corner of the screen, and click the menu drop-down.

- Select ***Access MyLab***.






3. Accessing the Course & Instructor Resources

- From the drop-down menu, select resources to review.




4. Reviewing the eText
