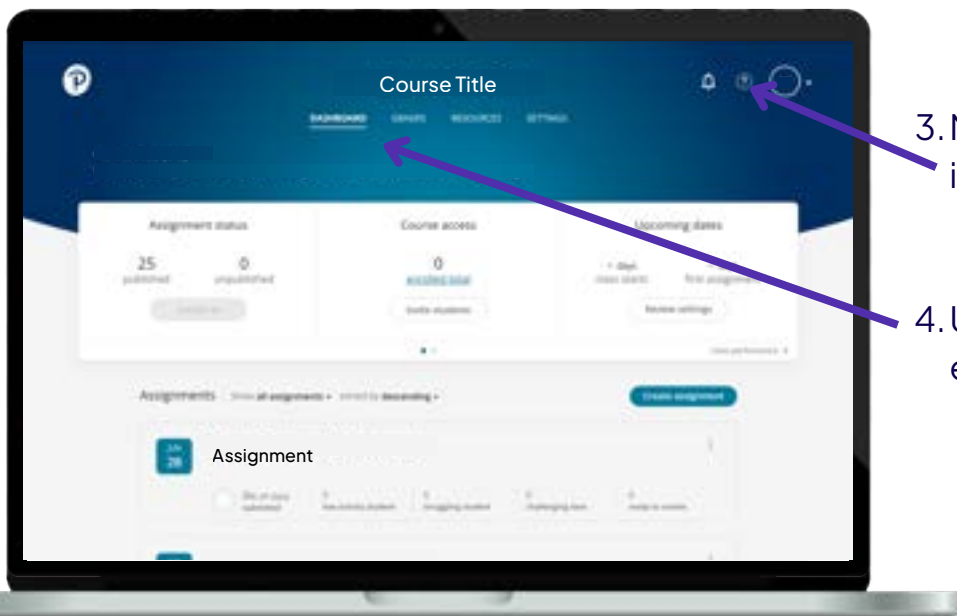


Exploring course resources

2. Your course will open to the 'Dashboard' which provides a snapshot of your course activity



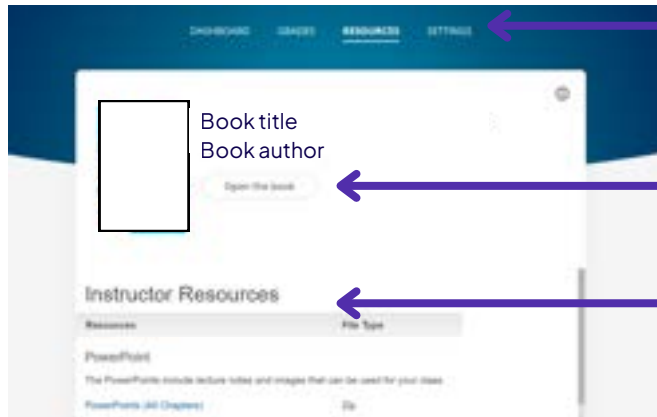

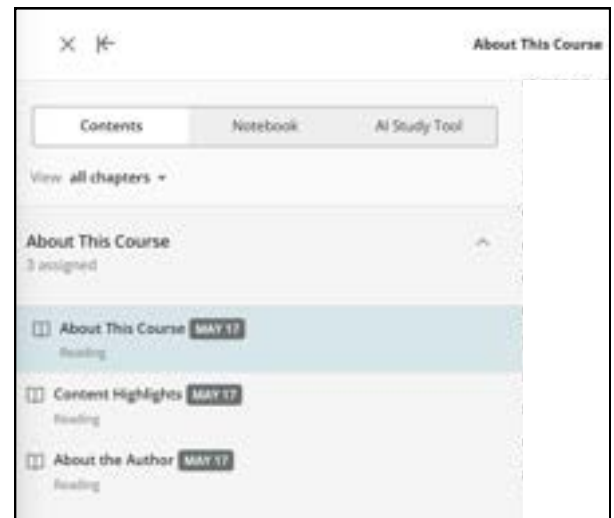
Locating instructor resources

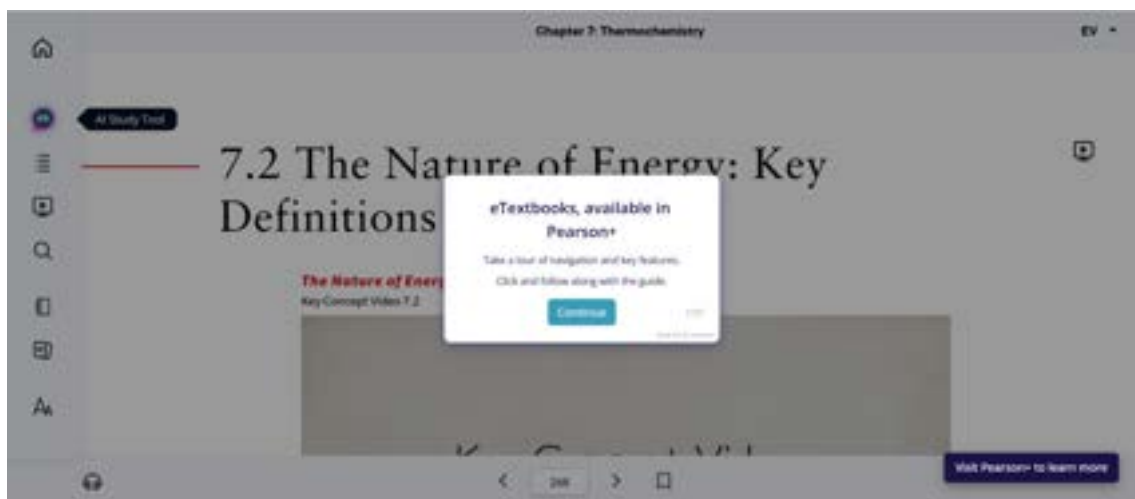
