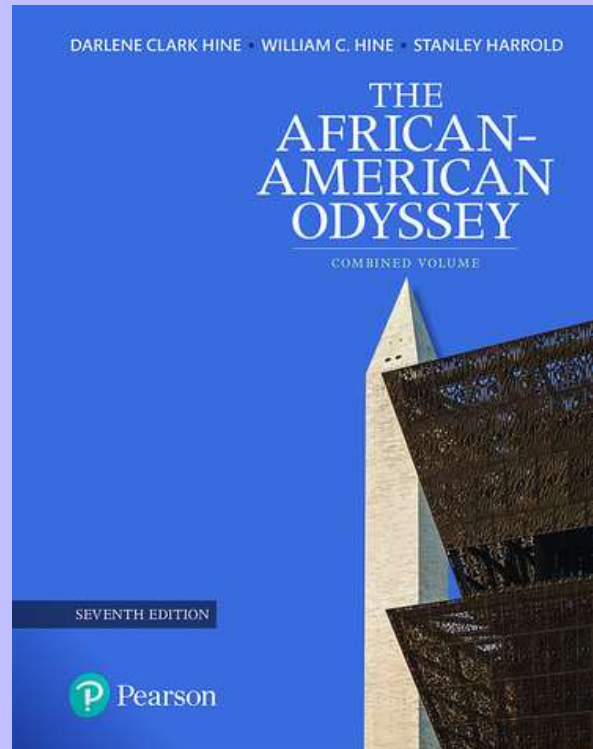
Detailed timeline: Includes chronological events and discussion of key individuals through Profile boxes that explores shared experiences of African Americans across time and place.

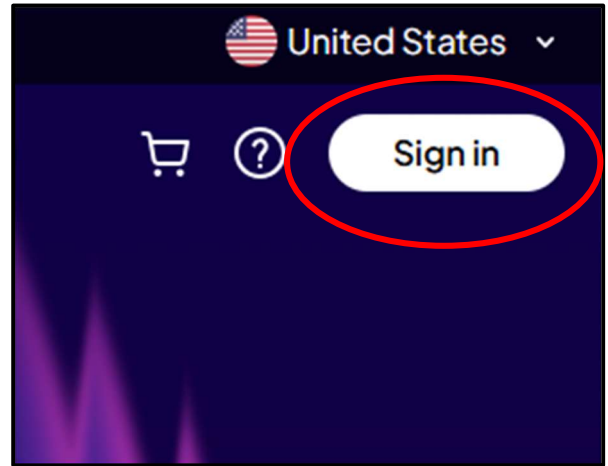

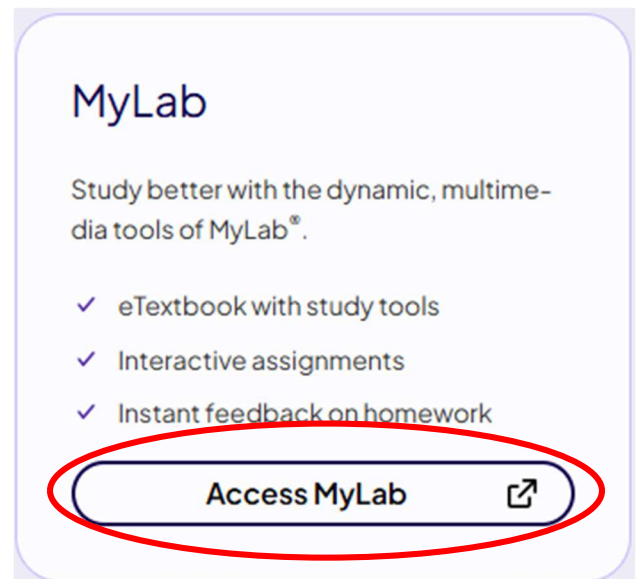
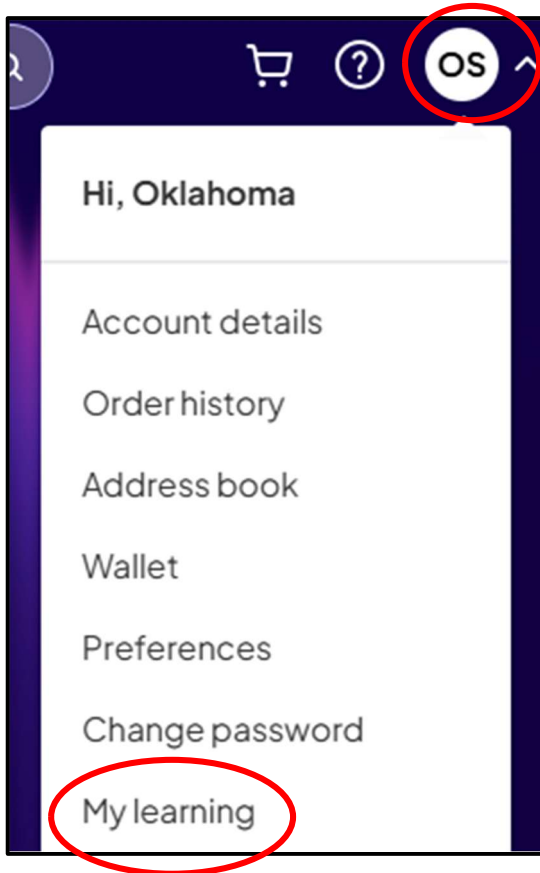
1. Logging Into Your Account

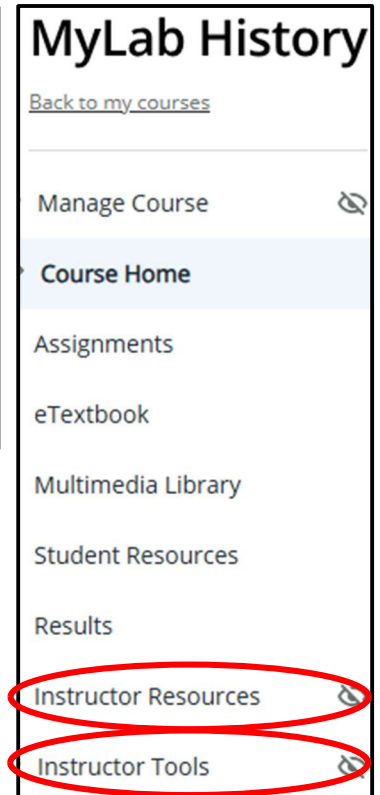
2. Logging into MyLab

- Review resources such as PowerPoints, Instructor’s Manual and TestBank with TestGen.

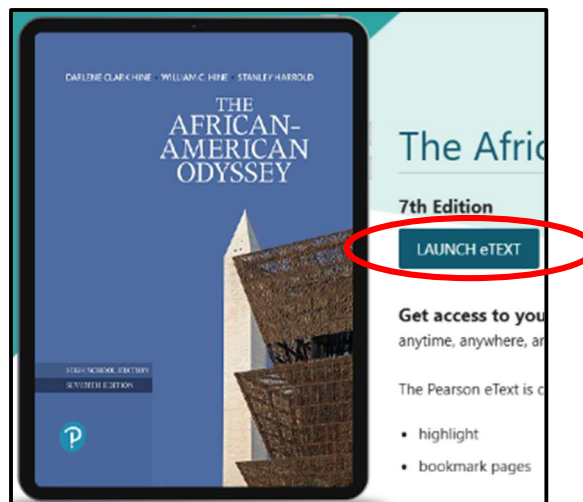
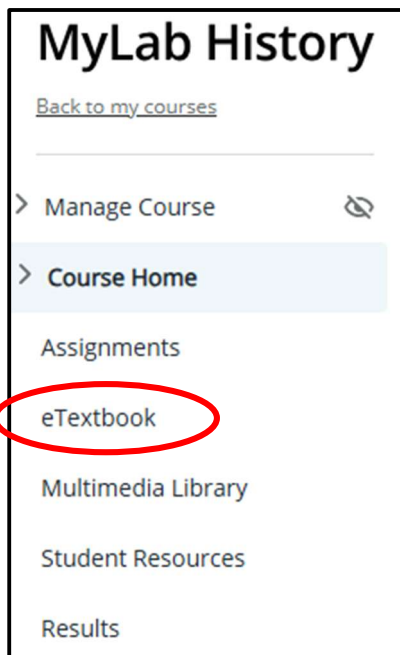

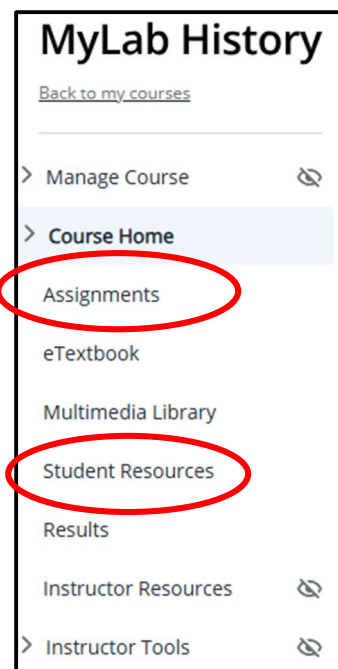
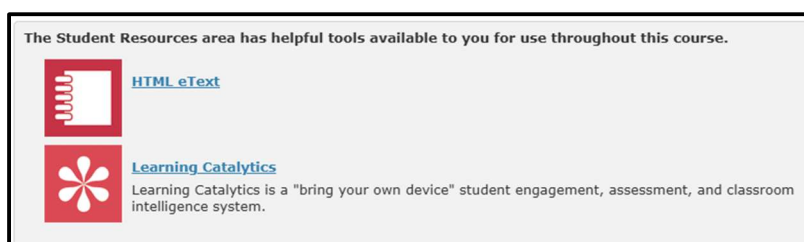
4. Reviewing the eText
