Content focus: Covers the recent geographical science and statistics with the latest data on current events, applied examples of human geography on local, regional and global scales.

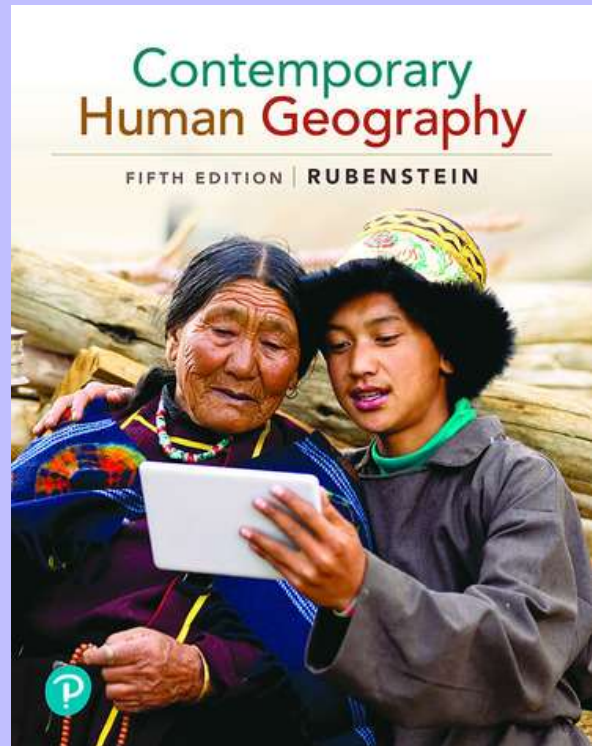

2. Logging into MyLab

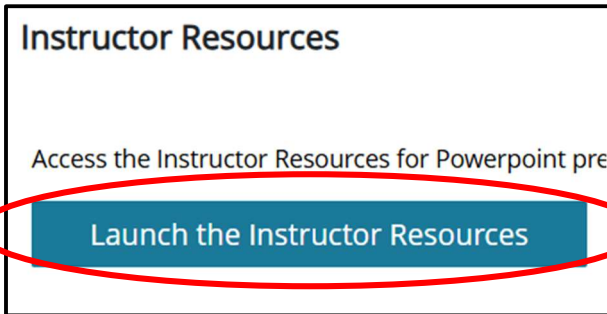
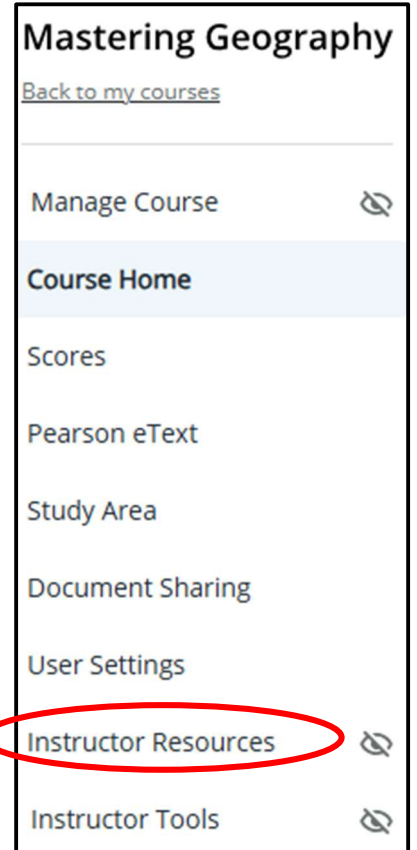
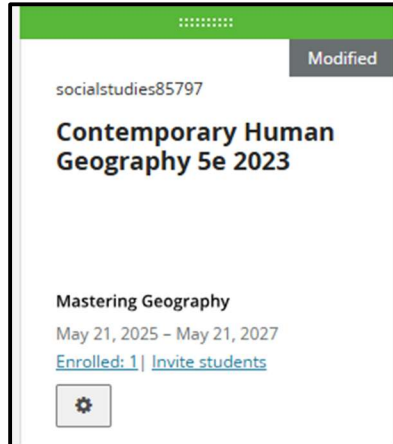


- Once logged in, return to top-right corner of the screen, and click the menu drop-down.

- Select "Access Mastering".



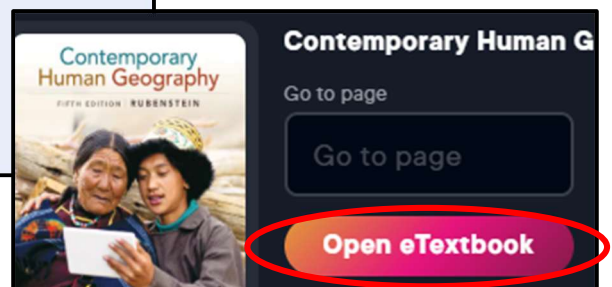
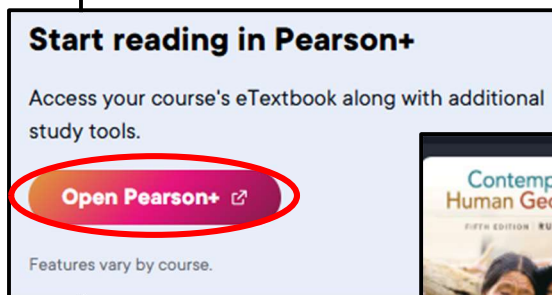
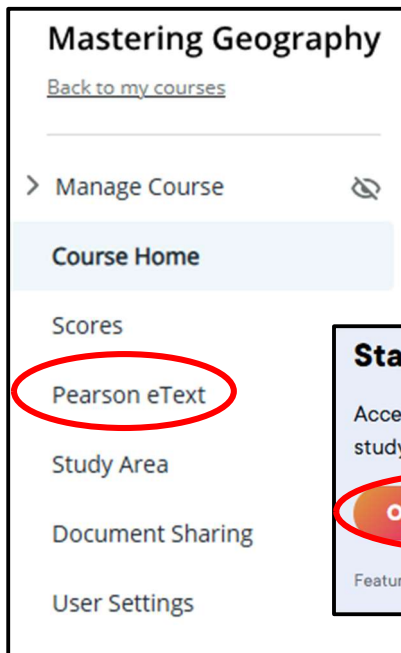
3. Accessing the Course & Instructor Resources

- Select “Launch the Instructor Resources.” In the window that opens, browse resources like Instructor Resource Manual and TestBank with TestGen.



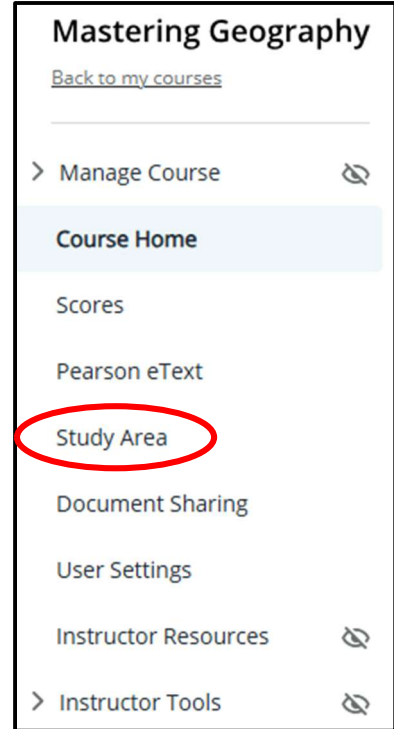
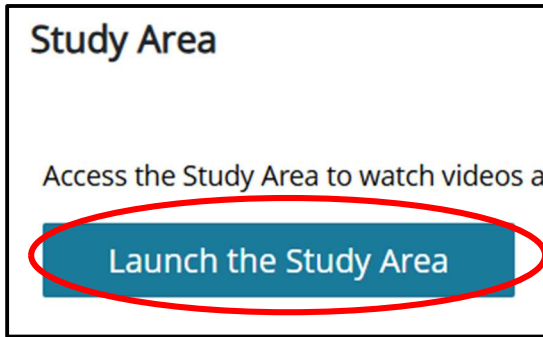
4. Reviewing the eText
