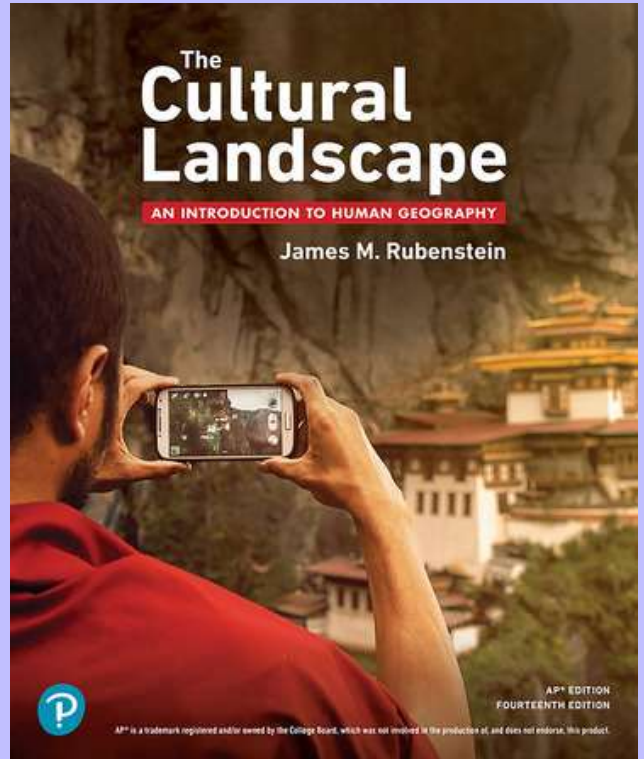

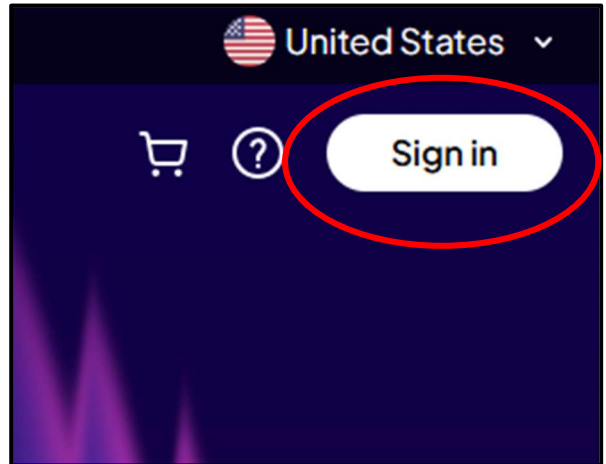

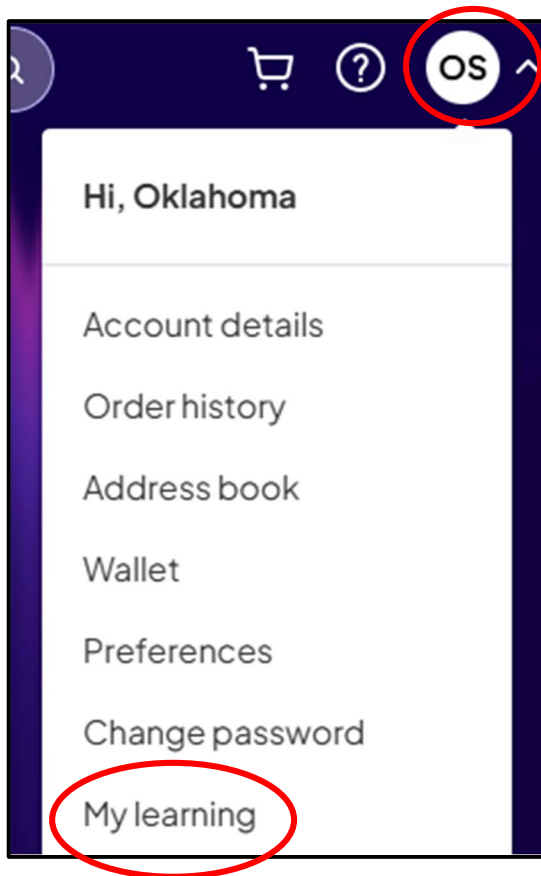

### 1. Logging Into Your Account

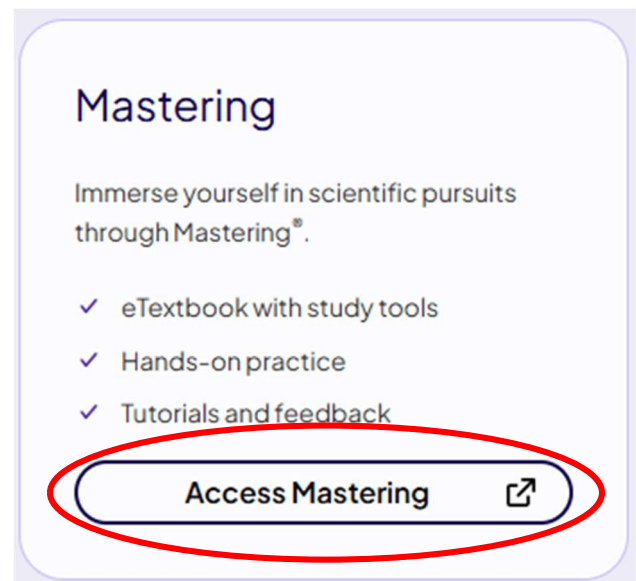

### 2. Logging into Mastering

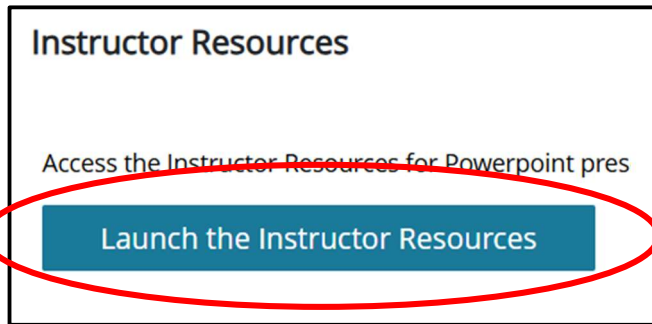
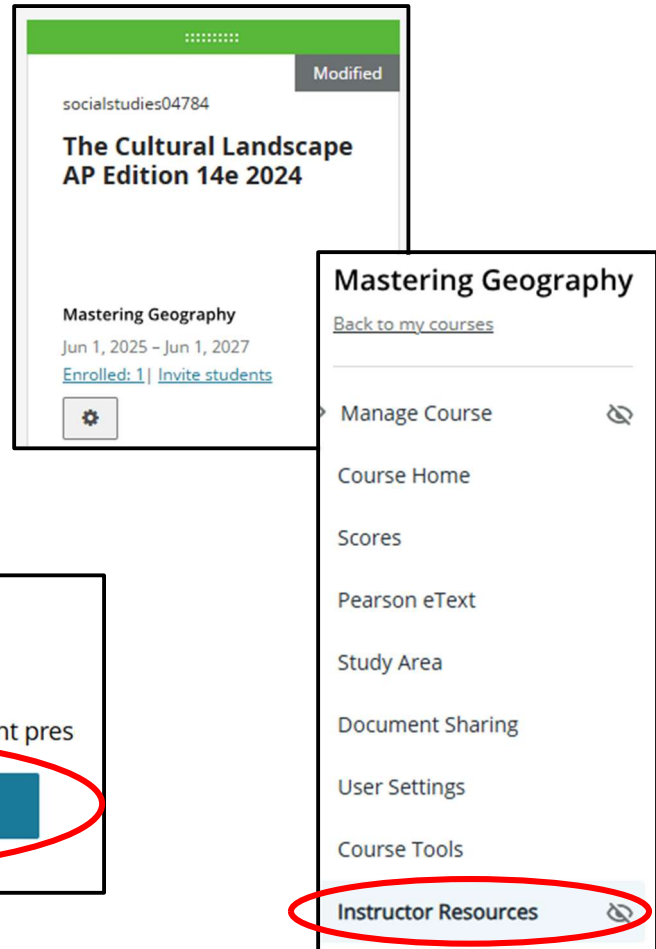


- Once logged in, return to top-right corner of the screen, and click the menu drop-down.

- Select "Access Mastering".



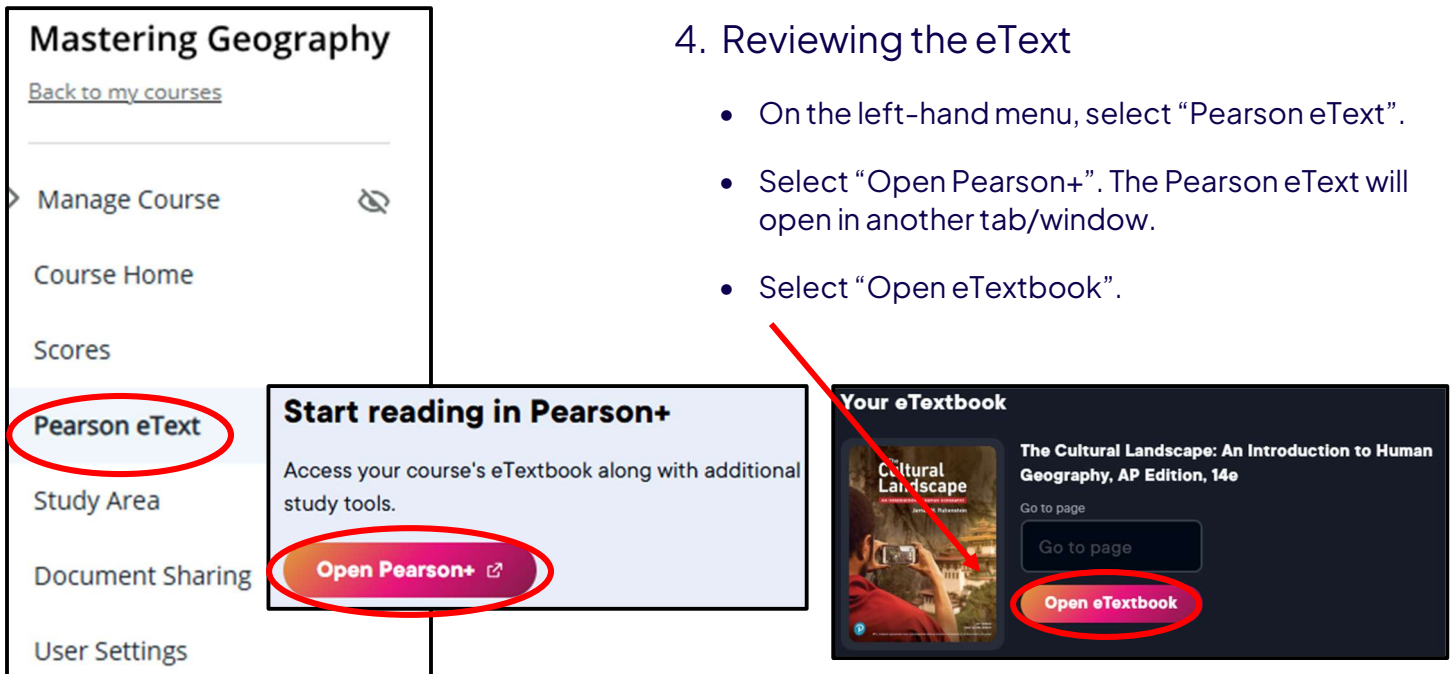
### 3. Accessing the Course & Instructor Resources

- Select “Launch the Instructor Resources”.



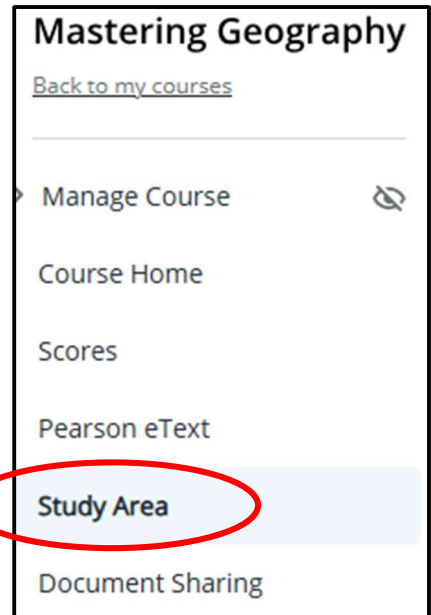
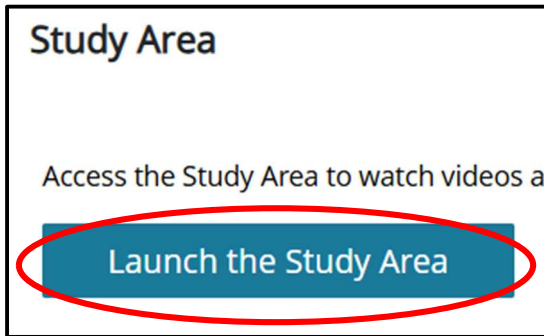
### 4. Reviewing the eText
