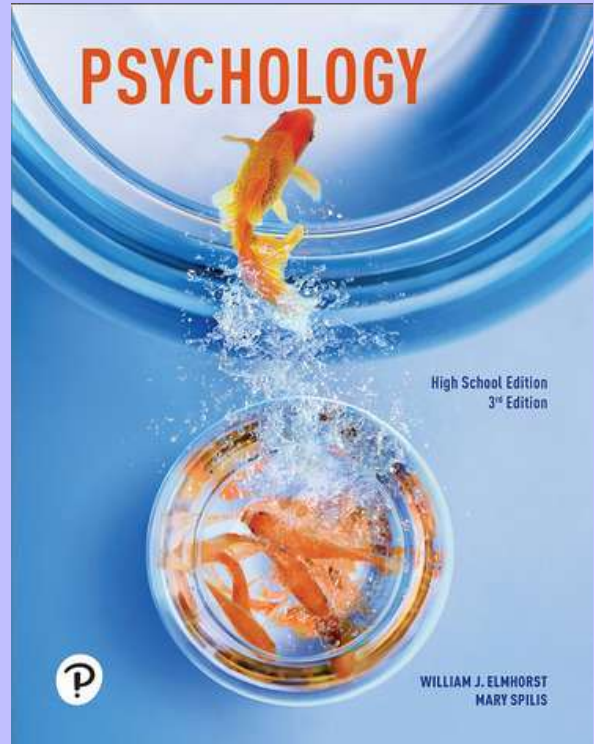

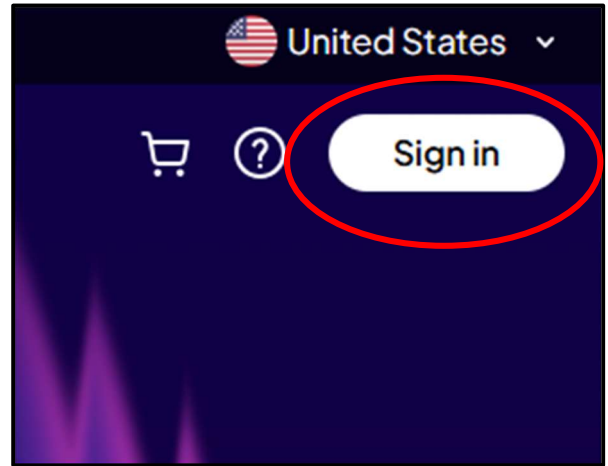

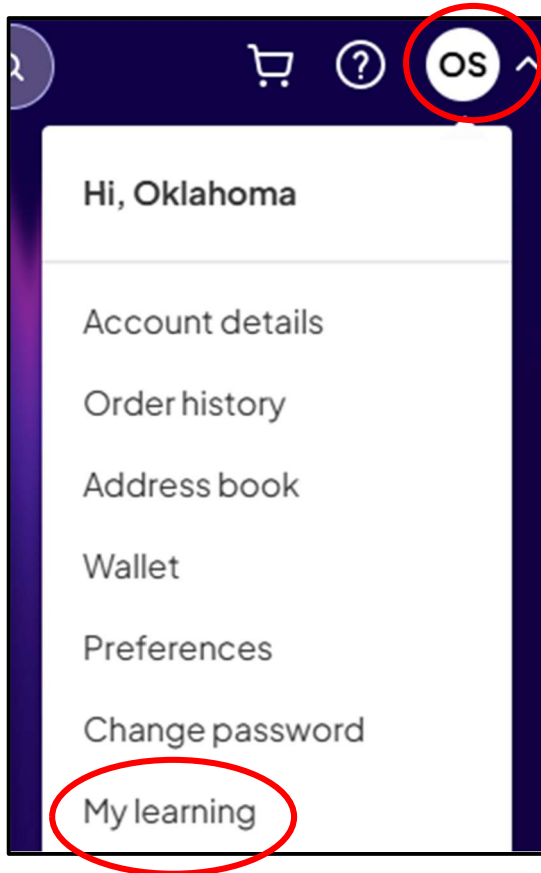

1. Logging Into Your Account

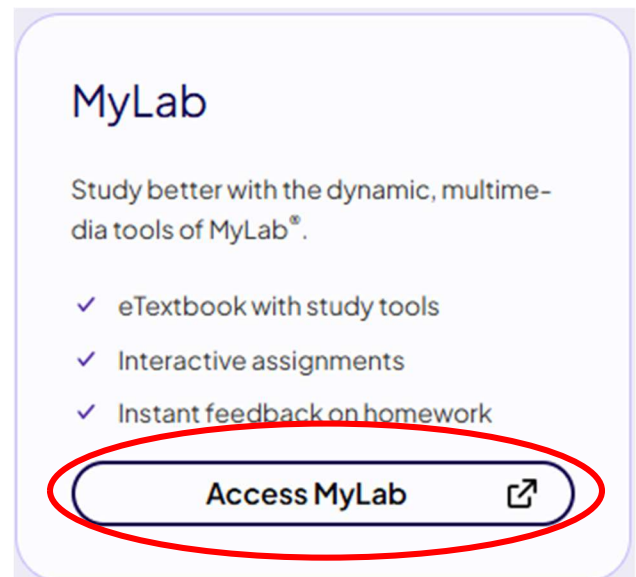

2. Logging into MyLab

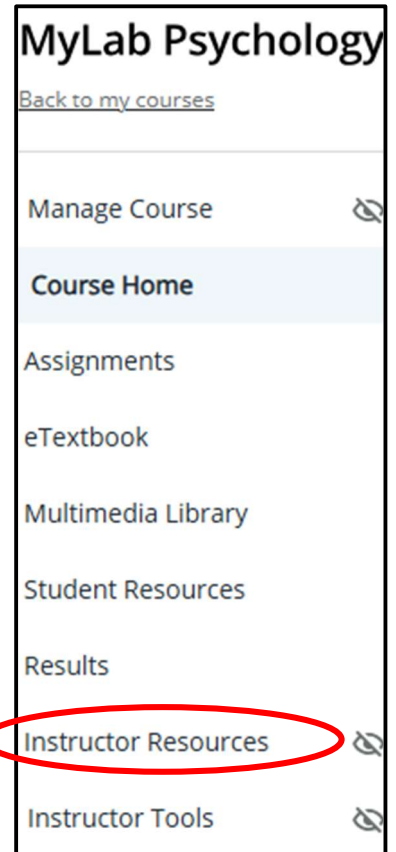


- Once logged in, return to top-right corner of the screen, and click the menu drop-down.

- Review resources such as PowerPoints and TestBank with TestGen.

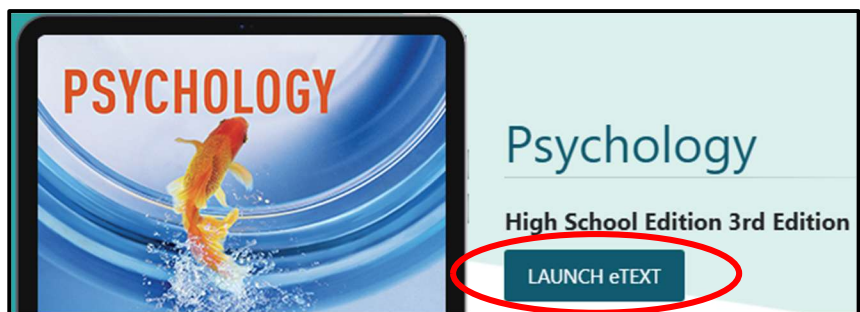
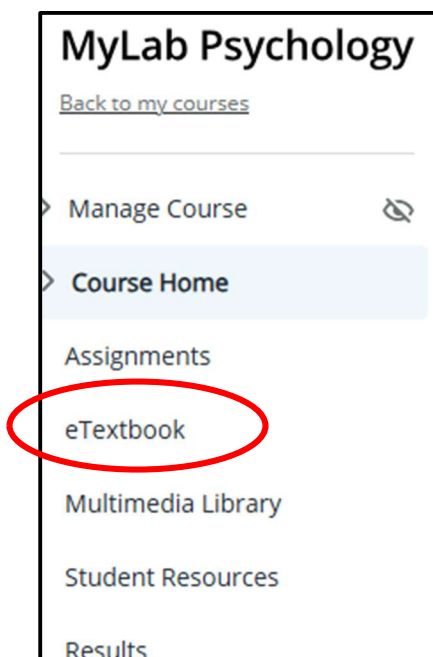

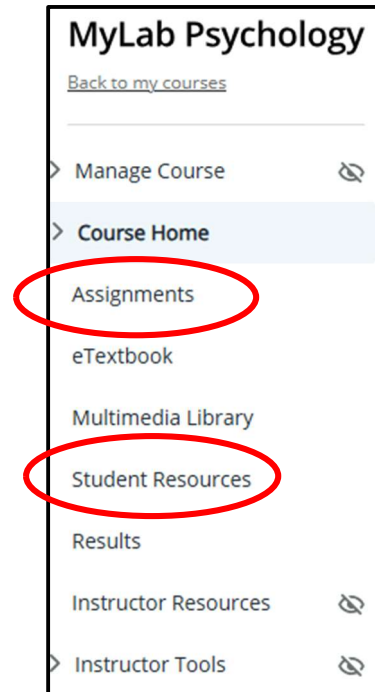
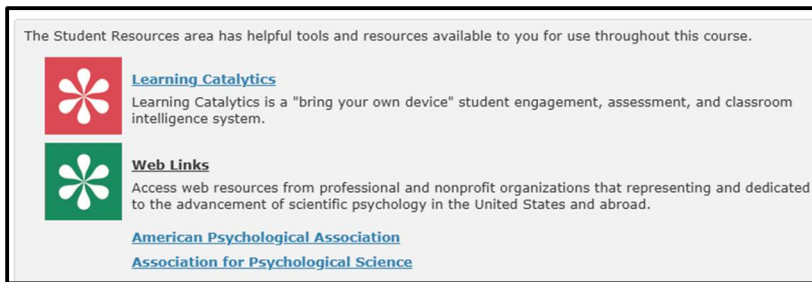
4. Reviewing the eText
