New and updated features of this title

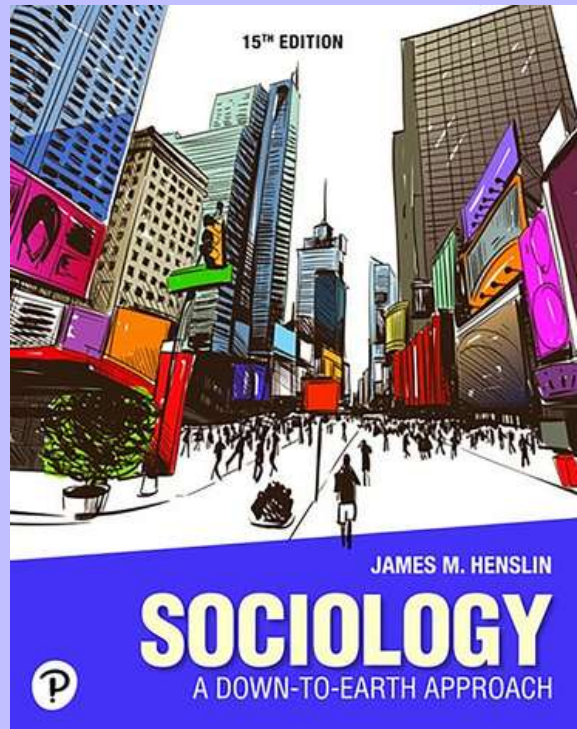
Author Jim Henslin has updated the text thoroughly to reflect recent events and contemporary issues. Highlights of new and updated content include the following:

Coverage of developments in technology in Chapter 6 includes how programmers are humanizing Artificial Intelligence by building empathy into AI devices.

Discussions of deviance in Chapter 9 include information on how the FBI built its own encrypted chat app, advertised it on the dark web and sold it to international criminals.

Fresh additions to the text's feature boxes stress topics relevant to students' lives. Examples include a new Applying Sociology to Your Life box entitled "Your Work and Your Future in the Global Village" and a new Down-to-Earth Sociology box called "Meet Your New Rulers," which focuses on the global elite's impact on society.

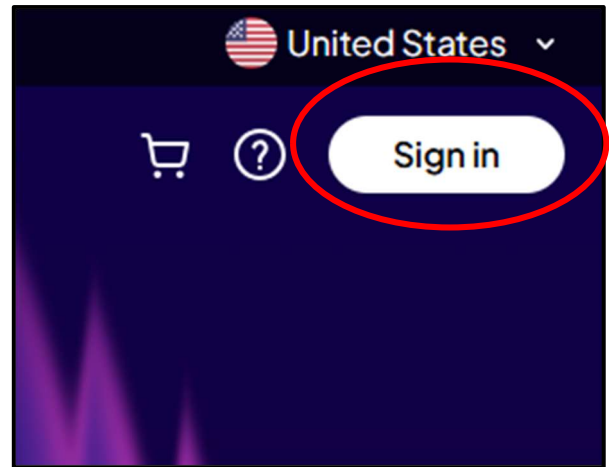

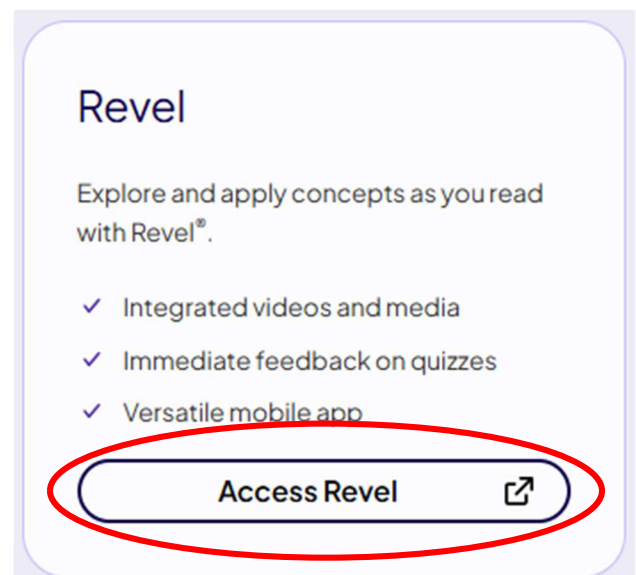
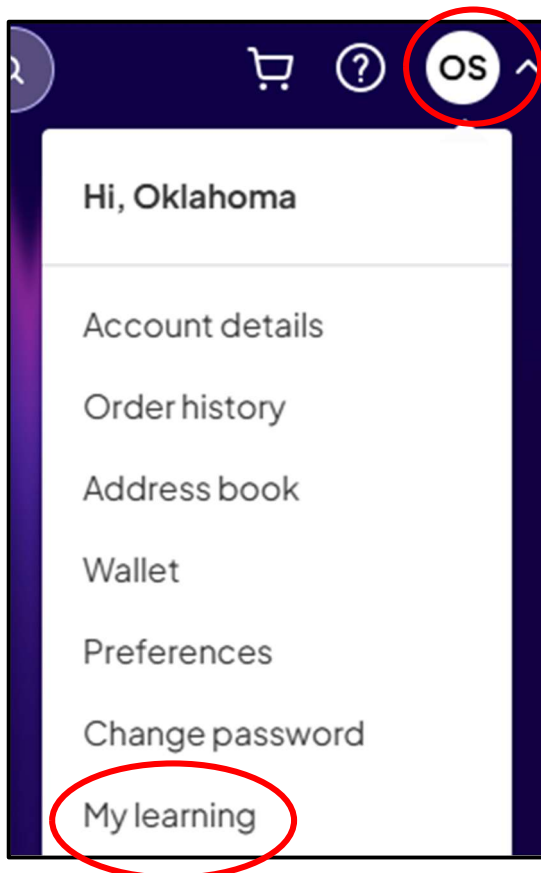
1. Logging Into Your Account

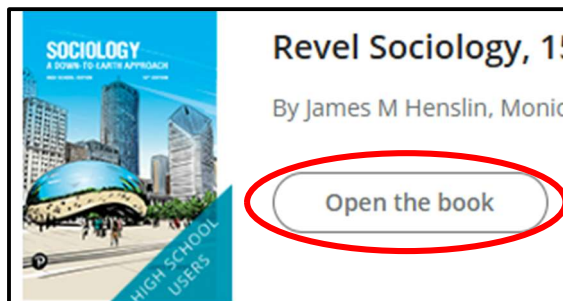
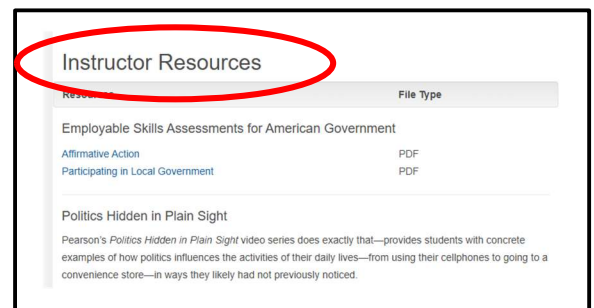
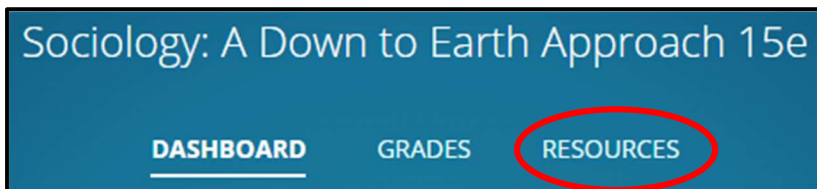
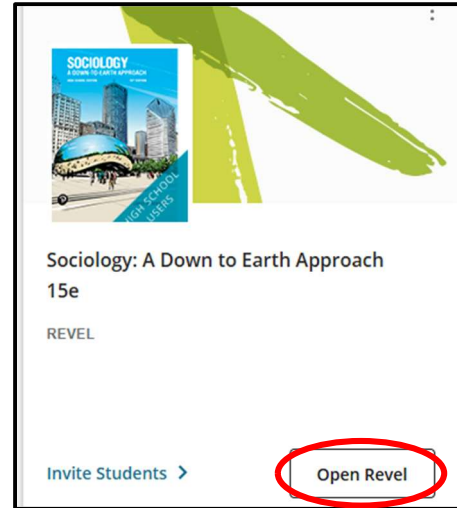
2. Logging into MyLab

- Select "Access Revel".



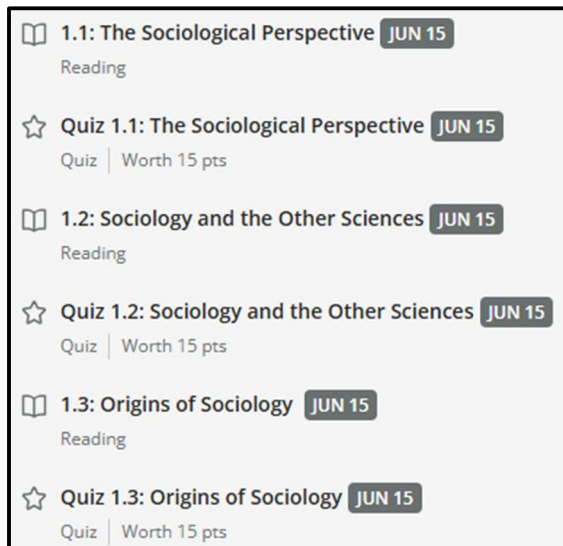
3. Accessing the Course & Instructor Resources

- Select “Resources” to review the Instructor Resources.



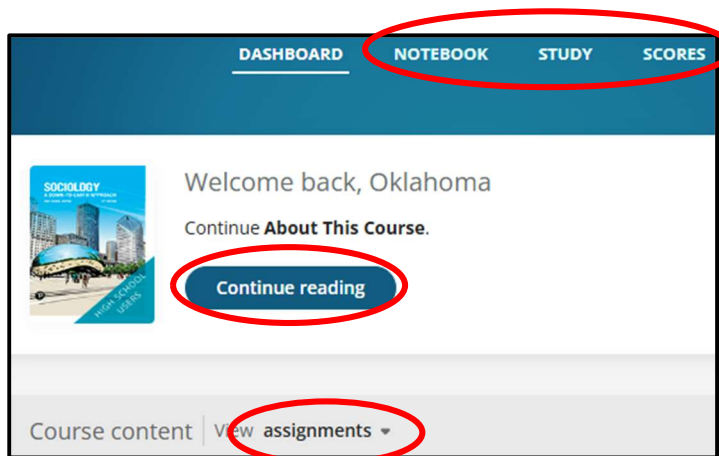
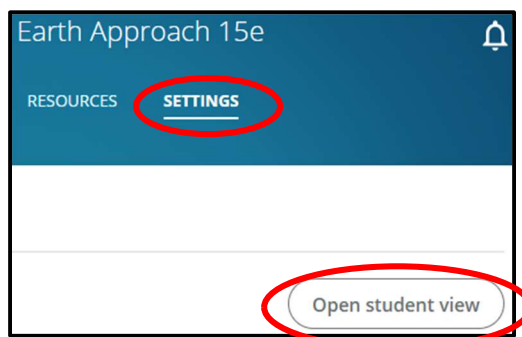
4. Reviewing the eText
