- The process (BTEC Teaching, internal assessment & quality assurance):

Process	Description
Qualification Specification	Outlines content and learning outcomes per unit for BTEC qualifications.
Assessment Methods	Learners are assessed using Pearson Set Assignments (PSAs) or Authorised Assignment Briefs (AABs), adaptable by the center.
Internal Assessment	Learners' work is internally assessed against assessment criteria and 'Equality, Inclusion and Diversity' (EIAD) statements by the center.
Internal Verification	Samples of assessed work are internally verified to ensure standards compliance within the center.
Standards Verification	Pearson verifies standards twice a year, ensuring compliance and quality assurance. Centers are allocated a Standards Verifier.
Certificate Claiming	Centers can claim certificates for learners who successfully complete the BTEC qualification, provided there are no compliance issues.

Day 2: Assessment Techniques

- Master assignment design and forms of evidence.
- Understand grading criteria and feedback delivery.
- Forge industry links for enriched learning experiences.

Day 3: Quality Assurance

- Navigate internal and external quality assurance processes.
- Prepare for Standards Verification visits and action plans.
- Access ongoing support for continued growth.



End Point Assessment (EPA):

- Deliver a presentation showcasing key competencies.
(Up to 45 minutes + 10 minute Q&A session)
- Gain certification upon successful completion.

Certification and Digital Badge:

Delegates are awarded a certificate and a digital badge upon successfully completing the programme and EPA. This signifies their mastery of skills required to deliver effective BTEC programmes at levels 2 and 3. Using Credly, badges can be shared on social media or offline, enhancing professional recognition and credibility.
