What is the BTEC Teacher Educator Programme?

This CPD programme is designed to equip educators with the knowledge, skills, and confidence to deliver Pearson's BTEC International vocational qualifications.

By the end of the programme, participants will be able to:

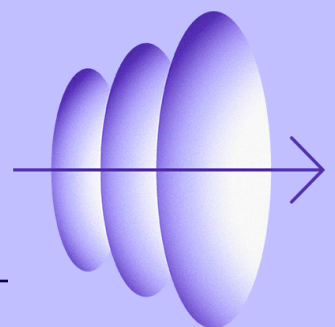
- Plan and deliver BTEC International vocational qualifications effectively.

- Apply best practice in delivery, assessment, and feedback.
- Conduct internal verification and ensure quality assurance.
- Build and present a professional portfolio evidencing their teaching practice.
- Achieve the "BTEC Teacher Educator" digital badge and certificate.

Key Features

- **Hands-on Learning:** Engage in interactive sessions in a cohort of up to 15 participants.
- **Professional Development:** Earn 25 CPD hours over the 5-day programme.
- **End Point Assessment:** Showcase your understanding and earn a digital badge.

Delivery Model

- The programme is delivered over five consecutive full days, with sessions typically running from **10:00am to 4:00pm** each day.
- All training sessions (Units 1–5) are delivered **face to face**.
- Each participant receives bespoke coaching and mentoring throughout the programme.
- The End Point Assessment (Unit 6) is conducted as an online event. Learners have five weeks from the last face-to-face session to prepare for their EPA.
- Successful completion of the programme and EPA leads to the award of the "**BTEC Teacher Educator**" digital badge and certificate.

End Point Assessment (EPA):

- Deliver an online portfolio showcase. (Up to 45 Minutes + 10-Minute Q&A session)
- Gain certification upon successful completion.

Certification and Digital Badge:

Delegates are awarded a certificate and a digital badge upon successfully completing the programme and EPA. This signifies their mastery of skills required to deliver effective BTEC programmes at levels 2 and 3. Using Credly, badges can be shared on social media or offline, enhancing professional recognition and credibility.
