Does Charlie like rainy days? [No] Who shares their umbrella? [Ola]







ROSE CHARLIE

Oh, no! Now it's snowy!

Quick! The cave!

What's the weather like now? [It's snowy.] Where do they go? [To a cave.]







OLA ROSE

(thinks) Oooh! It's windy and cool! Come on, Charlie. Come on, Ola.

What's the weather like now? [It's windy and cool.] Where are Charlie, Rose and Ola? [In a cave.]







ROSE It's sunny now!

CHARLIE Phew!

What's the weather like now? [It's sunny.]

Who's hot? [Charlie]

What would you bring to a picnic? (L1) [Encourage pupils to talk about what foods, games or equipment they might bring to a picnic.]







UNCLE DAN CHARLIE'S MUM

Well done, Charlie and Rose. You've got the picnic food! Welcome to your picnic!

Who has the picnic food? [Charlie and Rose] How many people are there at the picnic? [Nine] Is it a good day for a picnic? [Pupils' own answers]
