

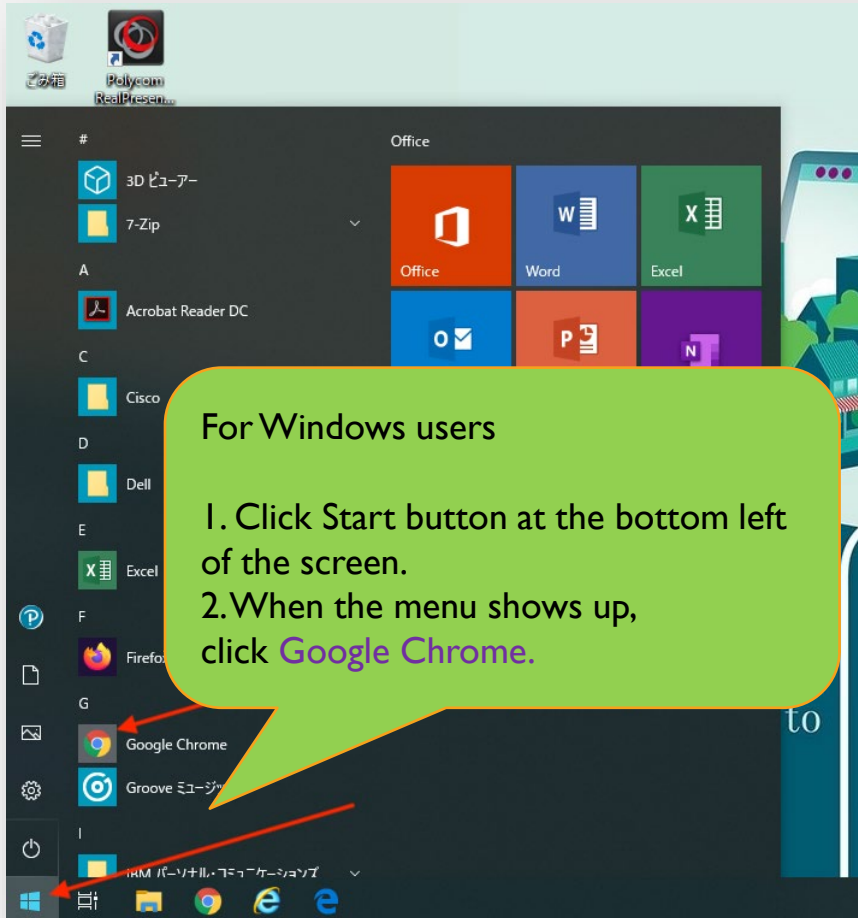

-How to register

! Please be noted that Pearson English Portal does not work on Internet Explorer .



For MAC users

Click either Safari or Chrome on the dock.



※ For Windows users who have yet installed Chrome, it is required to install it. For those who have already installed Chrome, no need to re-install it.

1. Enter “Chrome download” in the search field and click search button.

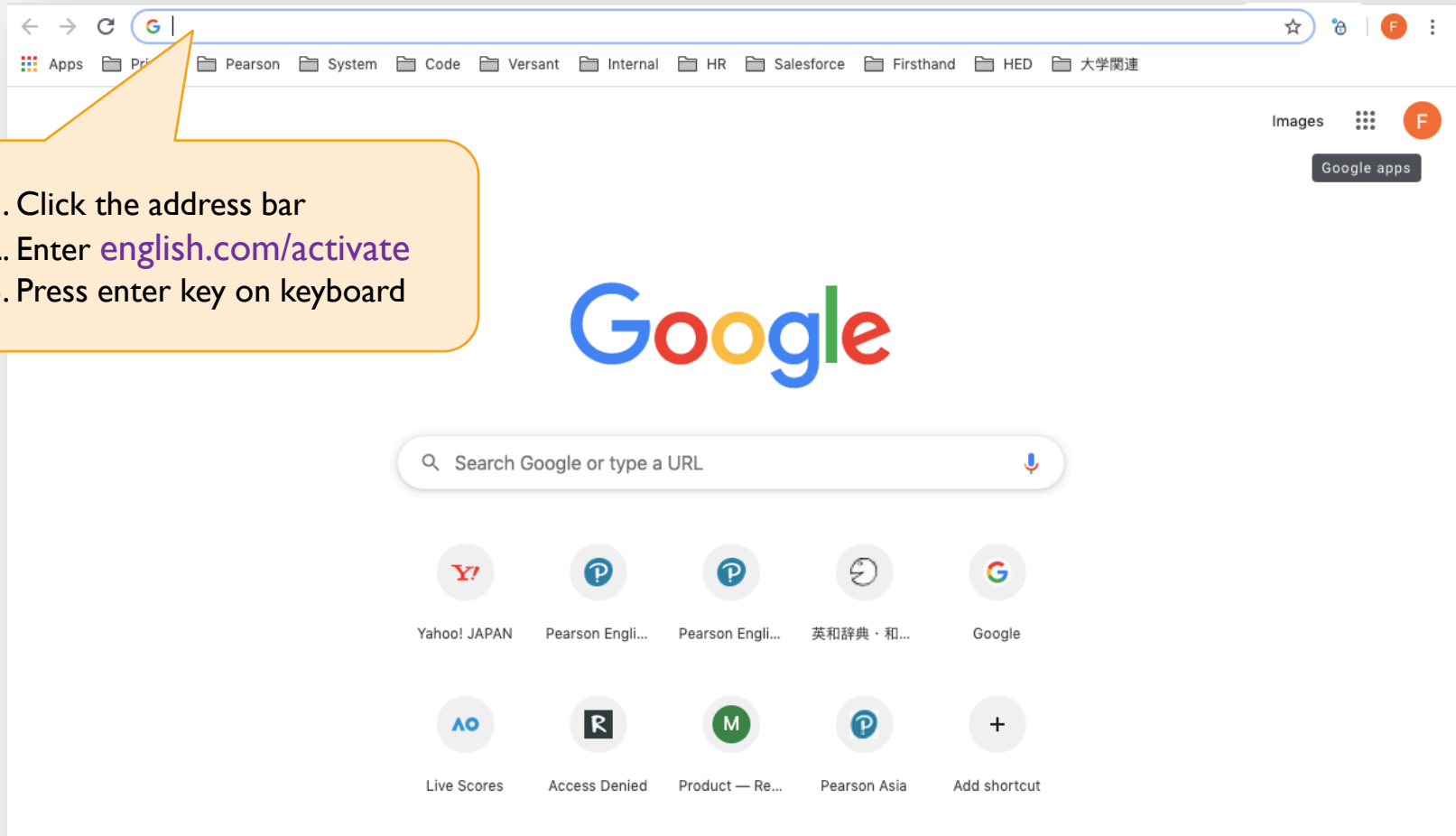
3. Click **Download** button to proceed with the installation.

2. Chrome homepage will show up in the search result and click the link of it.

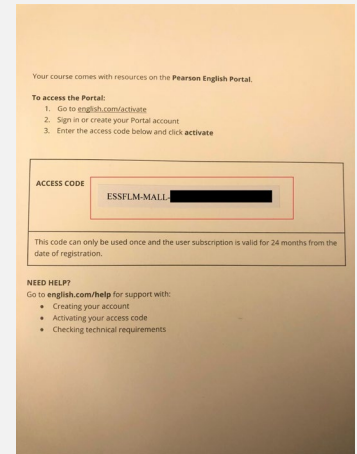

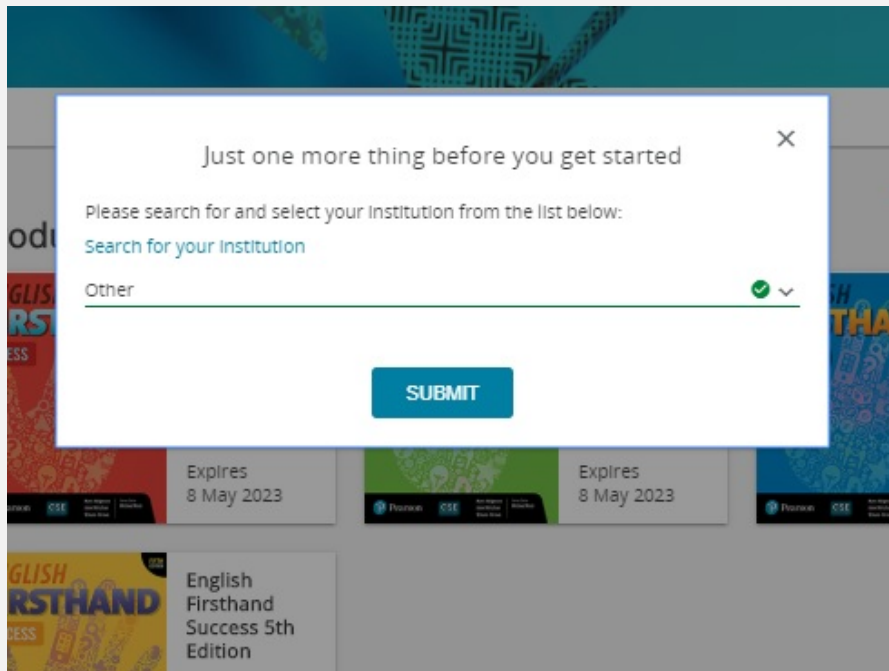

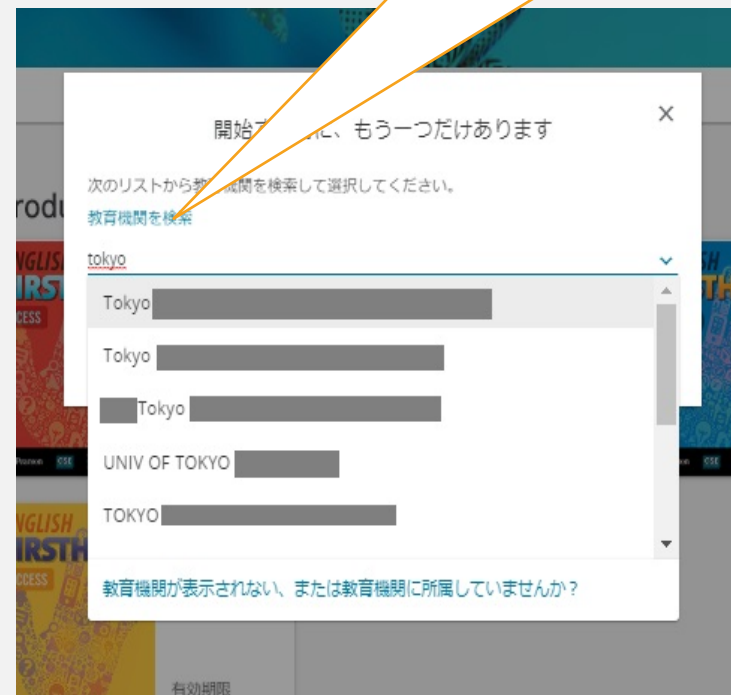
