

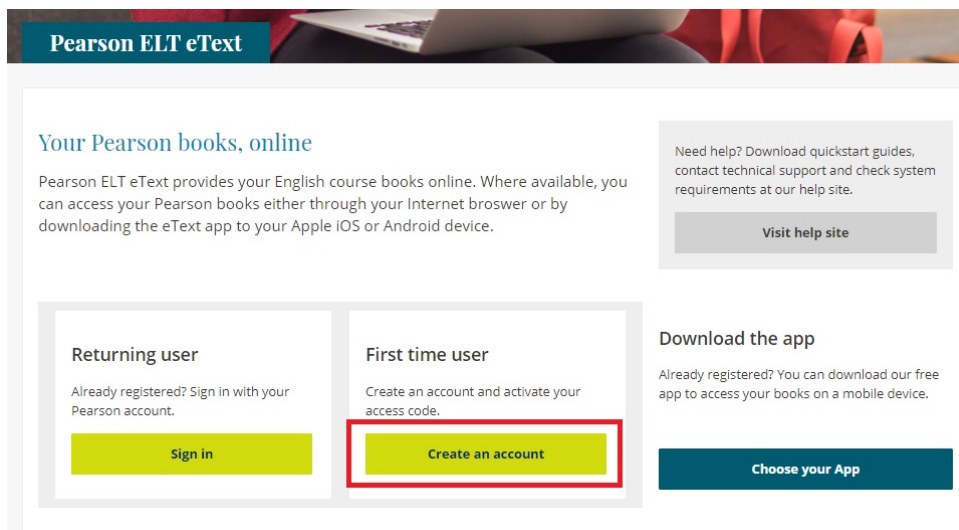
## eText - Teacher Registration

**⚠ Please use either **Google Chrome** or **Safari**.**

To gain instructor access to eText, you need to create an account first. To register, you will require an instructor access code. The registration process takes around five minutes.

1. Open [www.pearsonelt-etext.com](http://www.pearsonelt-etext.com) in your browser and click the "Create an account" in the First time user.
