

## MyMobileWorld – How to Use (For Students)

### Student Registration

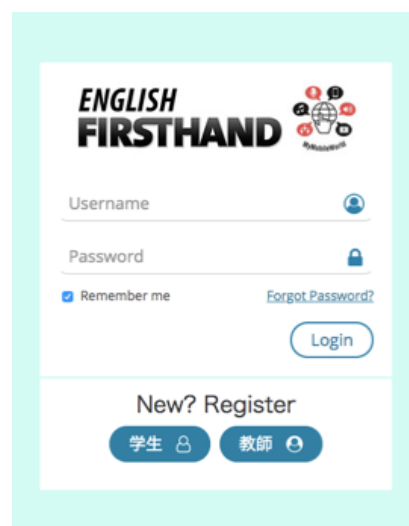
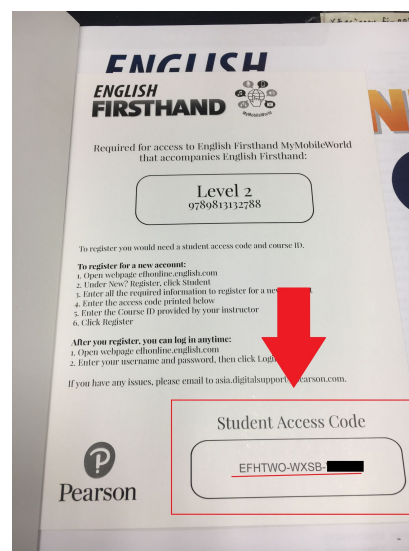
In order for you to be able to register successfully to your teacher's course, you will need two things:

- The **student access code** for the correct level of English Firsthand MyMobileWorld (provided in your student book)
- The **course ID** you want to enroll to, for example: EFHONE\_38\_Kri. If you don't have one, contact your teacher.

1. Go to [efhonline.english.com](https://efhonline.english.com).

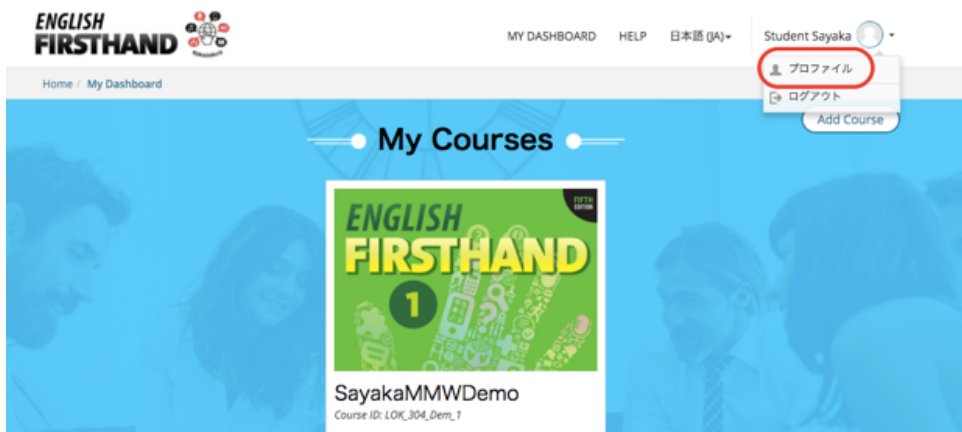


2. Click **"Student"** under **"New? Register"**
3. Enter in all the required information such as username, password, email address, first name and last name, country. Also provide security question and answer.
  - We recommend to use your email address as your username to ensure a unique username.
    - Please note that the username must be lowercase.
  - For passwords, please refer to the following rules:
    - Password must be at least 8 characters and 1 number
    - Must contain both uppercase and lowercase
    - Must include at least one special character, such as @, \*, -, # etc.Please write down your username and password and keep them safe in order to not forget them.



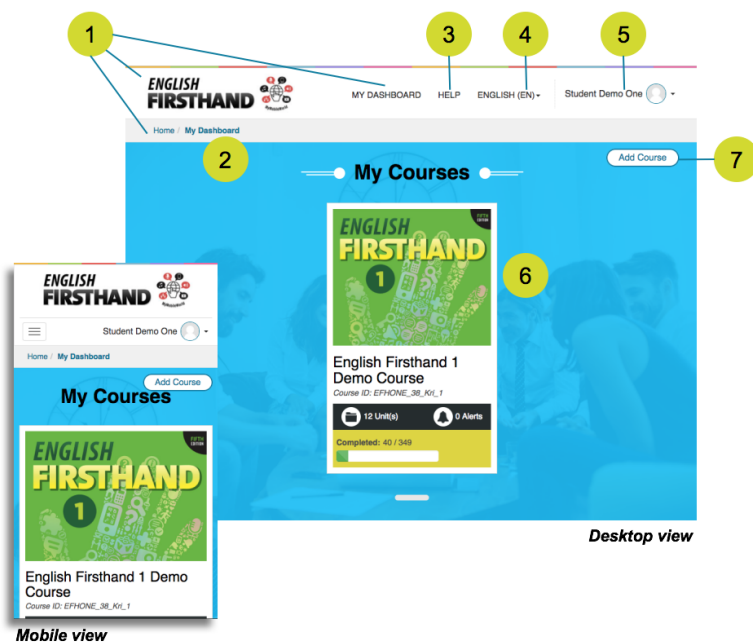
4. Enter your student access code from your student book.  
\* Please note that hyphens in access codes must be entered as well.
5. Enter the Course ID that your teacher has provided to you.
6. Read the site policy and check the box next to **"I understand and agree to the site policy"**
7. Click **"Register"**.
8. Once successful, you'll see a message on the screen that looks similar to this below:  
*Your account has been created at 'Pearson Asia' successfully. To recover your password, use 'LFCKXDIATGIOCX6'. You can find this ID at your profile page. You have been enrolled as a Student into the course 'EFH 2 Testing - EFHTWO\_66\_Kri'. If you need help, please contact the site administrator.*
9. Click on **"Go to Dashboard"** to see the course you have just enrolled to.
10. Select "Profile" in the menu bar and confirm your **Password Recovery ID** - this ID is required in case you have lost your User ID or password. We recommend to save or memorize the recovery ID.

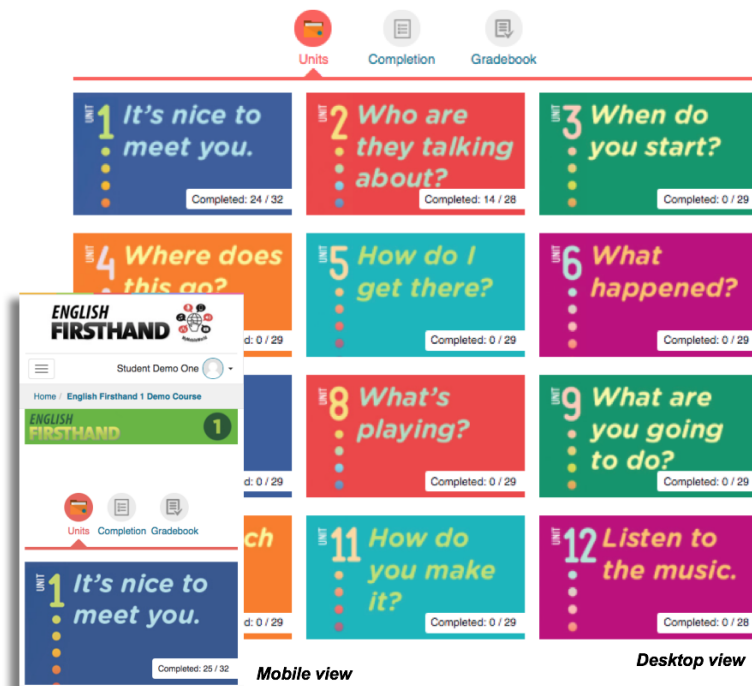
# About Each Section

## My Dashboard



1. Clicking English Firsthand logo, My Dashboard link or Home link will take user to My Dashboard page.
2. Breadcrumb: Show where you are located in this platform.
3. Help: Takes you to Support page.
4. Change interface language.
5. View/edit user profile.
6. List all the courses you are enrolled to.
7. Add Course: Allow you to enrol to another instructor's course.

# Course Page



Once a course is clicked you will be taken into the course page where you will see the 12 units as well as three buttons across the top: Units, Completion and Gradebook.

**Units:** This is the landing page for the course where you can see the 12 units inside the course.

**Completion:** Shows how many activities you have or have not completed and which that need to be manually graded by your teacher.

**Gradebook:** Shows your scores for all the activities you have done across units and sub-units (Vocabulary, Listening, Language Check, Real Stories and Video).

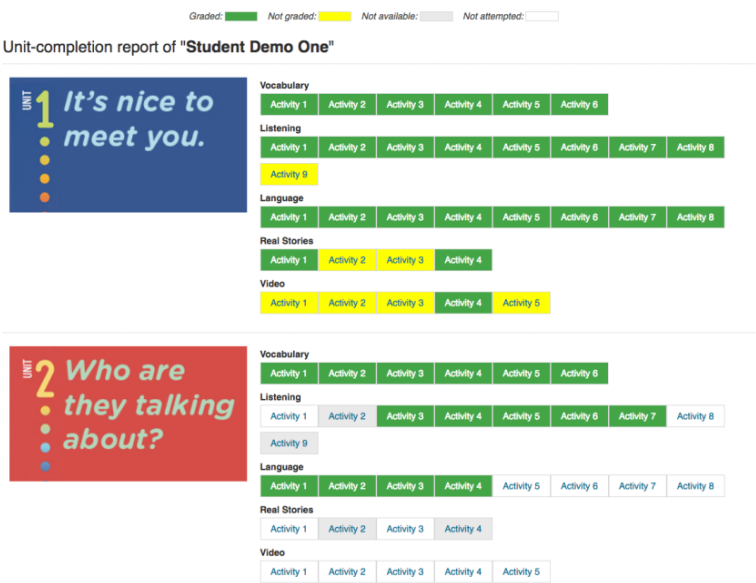

# Check Your Progress

## Student Completion Chart



Student Completion Chart is where students can check their progress in completing the activities.

*Graded:*  means that particular activity has been completed and received grades.

*Not graded:*  means that particular activity has been completed but not yet graded. This is usually for open-ended activities.

*Not available:*  means that particular activity is not available to students until another activity is completed and graded (green).

*Not attempted:*  means that particular activity is not yet attempted by students.

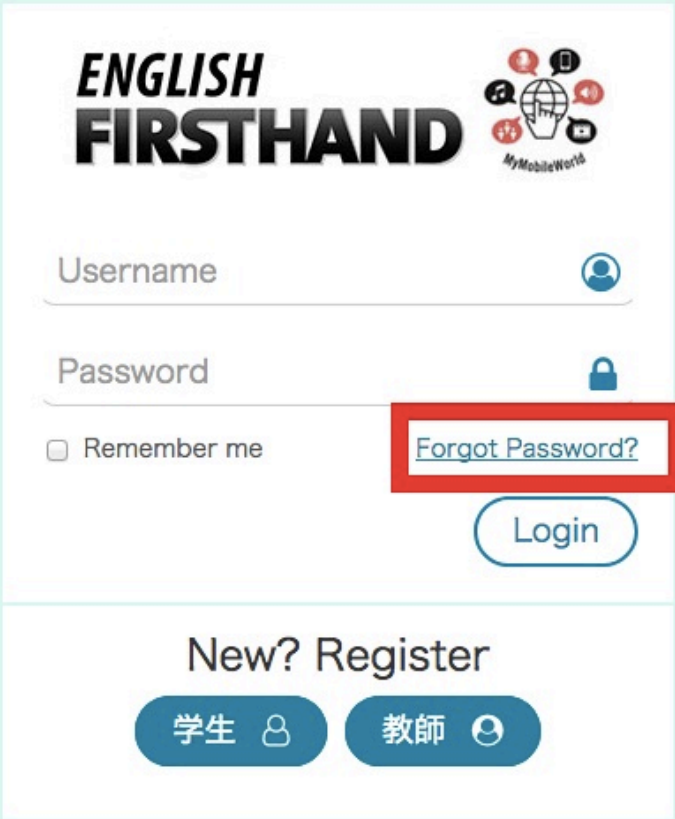
