


Using the Language of Chance Behaviours/Strategies	
<p>1. Student struggles to describe the likelihood of an event and chooses words randomly.</p>	<p>4. Student successfully describes the likelihood of an event and justifies thinking.</p>  <p>"I am certain to brush my teeth today because I always brush my teeth when I get up in the morning and before I go to bed at night."</p>
<p>2. Student describes the likelihood of an event, but decision is based on beliefs or what she or he wants to happen.</p>  <p>"I am certain to go to the moon because I love spaceships."</p>	<p>3. Student describes the likelihood of an event, but cannot justify thinking.</p>  <p>"I will never see a monkey driving a car, but I don't know why."</p>
