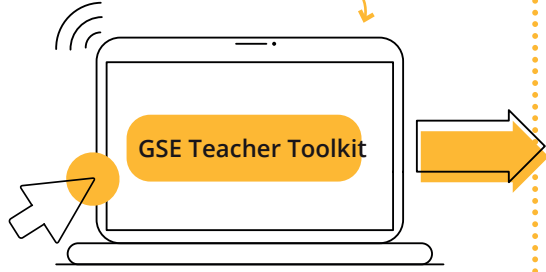
Introduction

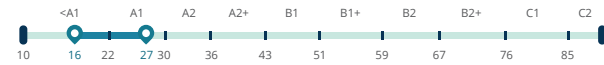

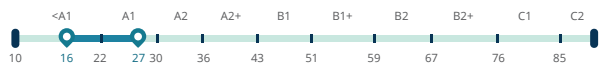
