



Title: Picnics Are Fun! Read Together Worksheet



# Picnics Are Fun! Read Together Rebus Story

**Teaching Notes**

- Review the theme vocabulary quickly using the **flashcards**.
- Pass out the worksheet (page 1).
- First, students listen to you read the story. Then, they will read it with you.
- Read the Title.
- **Say:** A ... (stop and hold up the picture of the picnic; see if students say it when you hold it up)
  
- Take out page 1 and read:
  - *I see (hold up picture of lemonade) lemonade.*
  - *I see (hold up pizza) pizza.*
  - *I see (hold up milk) milk.*
  - *I see (hold up cookies) cookies.*
  
- Ask children to read the story again with you.
- Ask children to try to remember the story and read it by themselves! Help them if necessary.
- Then read the instructions over the box: *Draw a picnic!*
- Ask children to draw what they heard in the story (lemonade, pizza, milk, cookies) in the picnic scene.
- Allow children to draw. Walk around and praise them for their good artwork!
- Ask children to check and make sure they've included milk, pizza, lemonade and cookies in their picnic drawing.
- Ask for volunteers to show their picnics to the class.
