

Make a bookmark

Levels 1-2

Teacher's notes

Making a bookmark is a fun way to get students into the habit of reading more regularly. If they have their own bookmark, then they are more likely to want to pick up a book and read!

In this activity, students can make their own bookmark based on their favorite book as well as draw a picture of their favorite scene. There's space for them to write about their favorite character and any new words that they have learned.

The bookmark becomes not only a way to find your page, but it can also help students engage in conversations about their reading in English and make them feel like they are making progress.
