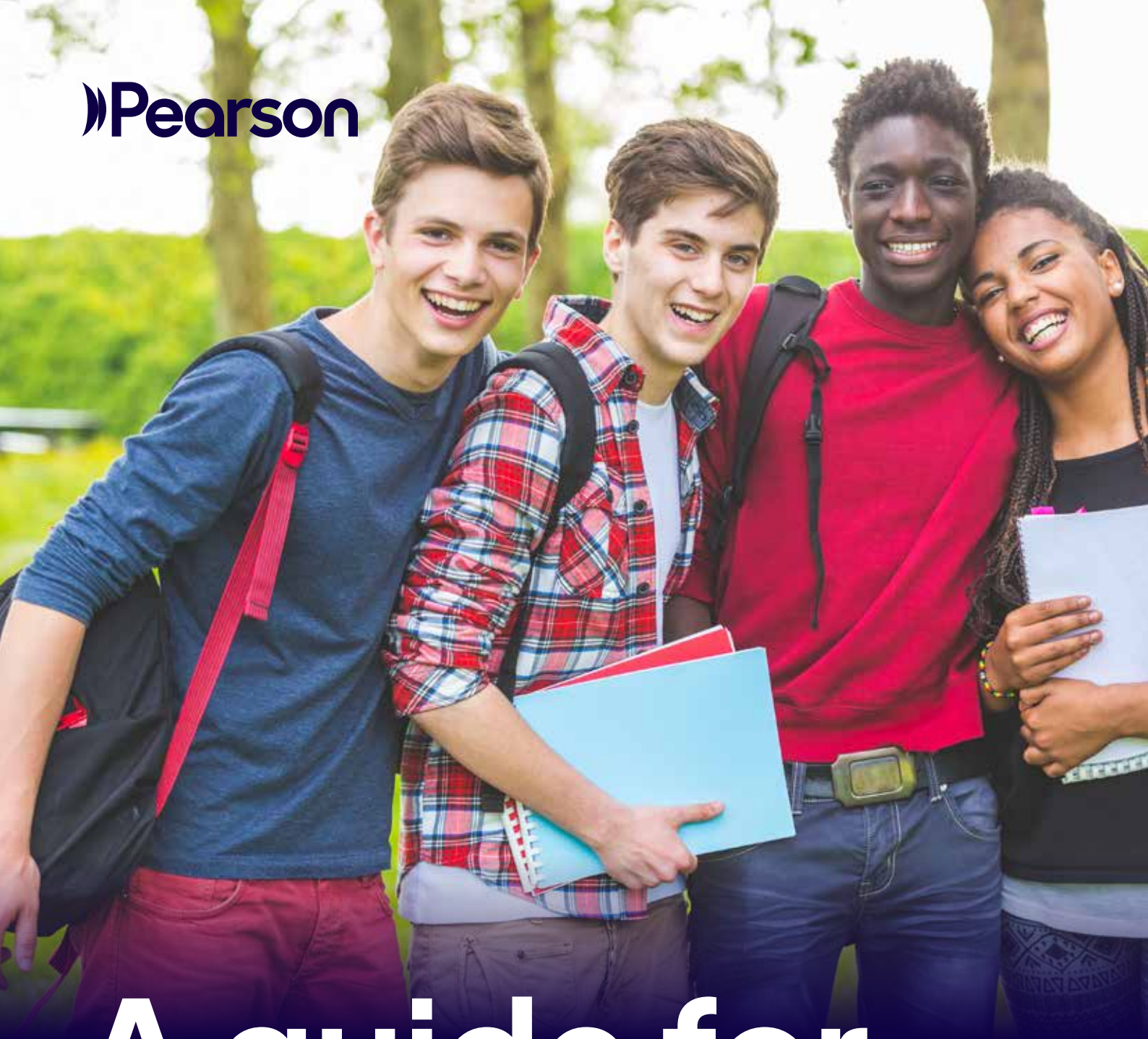

International GCSEs are globally recognised subject-specific qualifications with academic content and assessment designed specifically for 14- to 16-year-old international learners.

They are benchmarked, grade for grade, against the UK GCSE (General Certificates of Secondary Education) which are taken by students in England, Wales and Northern Ireland. GCSEs have been used as a benchmark to judge student ability for more than 25 years.

International GCSEs and UK GCSEs mainly involve studying the theory of a subject combined with some investigative work. Highly valued by schools, universities and employers, they are the first step towards further study at A level, International Baccalaureate, or direct entry into a range of careers.

Assessment options

For many subjects, we offer a choice of assessment options. Exams can be taken in one exam series at the end of the programme of study (linear), or throughout the course as individual modules (modular).

A modular approach means that exams can be taken and resat in any International GCSE exam series, giving students more exam practice

and more opportunities to receive feedback to improve their performance. While this approach works well for students who want to reduce the mental load at exam time, doing exams all in one go at the end of a period of study, the linear route, suits others better.

Also popular with students, onscreen assessment is available in addition to paper-based exams for a growing number of qualifications. About the 9–1 grading scale 1

In 2014, the UK Government introduced a nine-point grading scale (9–1) to raise standards and recognise top-performing students. This replaced the traditional A*–G grading. After consultation with international schools, Pearson Edexcel chose to follow the 9–1 grading scale to ensure comparability for our international students.

Since then millions of GCSEs and International GCSEs are awarded each year using the 9–1 grading scale, making it the most used and recognised grading scale for this qualification worldwide.

What this means for you

Because our Pearson Edexcel International GCSE qualifications are equivalent to and benchmarked, grade for grade, against UK GCSEs, you can be confident that they are recognised and respected across the world. They offer increased differentiation for your top learners (a grade 9 represents a higher level of attainment than A*) and will deliver the progression for your child that you want to see.

Why choose this qualification?

The Pearson Edexcel International GCSE (9–1) English B qualification aims to extend students' knowledge by broadening and deepening their skills in reading and responding to materials from a variety of sources, making comparisons between texts and analysing how writers achieve their effects and construct and convey meaning in written language.

There is one examination paper. Students may also take an optional spoken language endorsement.

- Exploring and developing transactional writing skills
- Exploring and developing discursive, narrative, and descriptive writing skills



International GCSE options: English

International GCSE (9–1) English Literature

Why choose this qualification?

The Pearson Edexcel International GCSE (9–1) English Literature qualification is designed to extend students' knowledge by broadening and deepening their skills to read and respond to a wide range of literary texts from around the world. They will develop an appreciation of the ways in which authors use literary effects and the skills needed for literary study and explore authors' use of language to create effects and find enjoyment in reading literature.

Assessment can be taken in one exam series, at the end of the programme of study (linear) or throughout the course as individual modules (modular).

There is one mandatory exam paper and a choice of an additional examined or non-examined assessment.

Onscreen assessment is available for this qualification as an alternative assessment format.

International GCSE (9–1) English as a Second Language

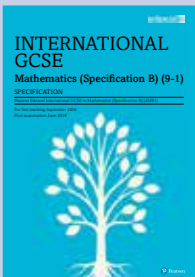

There is a Higher tier only, consisting of two examination papers. The first is 1.5 hours in length with shorter questions, the second is 2.5 hours in length with more in-depth questions.

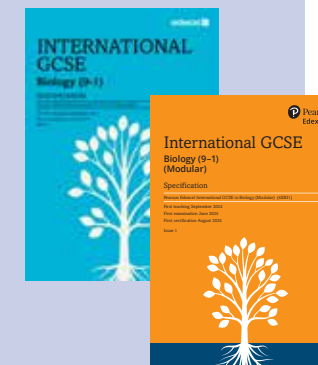

Assessment can be taken in one exam series, at the end of the programme of study (linear) or throughout the course as individual modules (modular). If students take a linear assessment approach, there are three exams. If they take a modular assessment approach, there are six shorter exams.

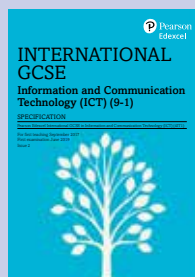

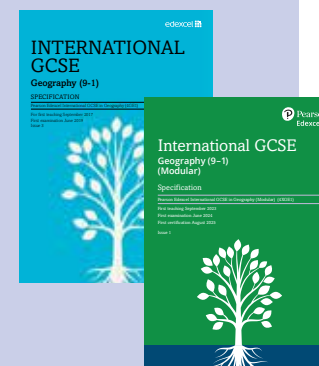

International GCSE (9–1) History

Why choose this qualification?

The Pearson Edexcel International GCSE (9–1) History qualification aims to extend learners' knowledge and understanding by broadening and deepening skills. 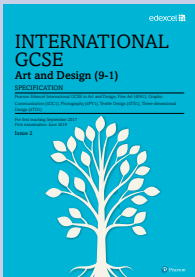
