


What started as a pilot in 2020, became a reality in 2022 when students sat their Pearson Edexcel International GCSE English Language exams onscreen for the first time.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the difference between onscreen and paper-based exams?

The exam papers are exactly the same. The only difference is that one is onscreen and the other on paper.

Can I run a blend of onscreen and paper exams?

You can choose to run onscreen and paper exams together and how you run this is your choice. You may decide to run paperbased exams in a hall and onscreen in the computer lab or everyone in the hall with some candidates on laptops.

How will onscreen and paper-based exams be awarded?

Both paper-based and onscreen follow the normal awarding process. Measures are in place to ensure fairness and consistency so that no student is advantaged or disadvantaged as a result of the medium they choose to take the exam in.

What are the technology requirements for International GCSE and A Level onscreen assessments?

Onscreen assessment is a highly secure, browser-based system. It is compatible and tested with multiple browsers and operating systems. Onscreen Windows and Mac devices can be centre or candidate owned.
