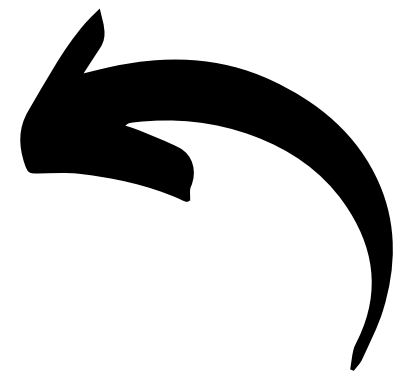

THE DEPARTMENT OF A LEVELS



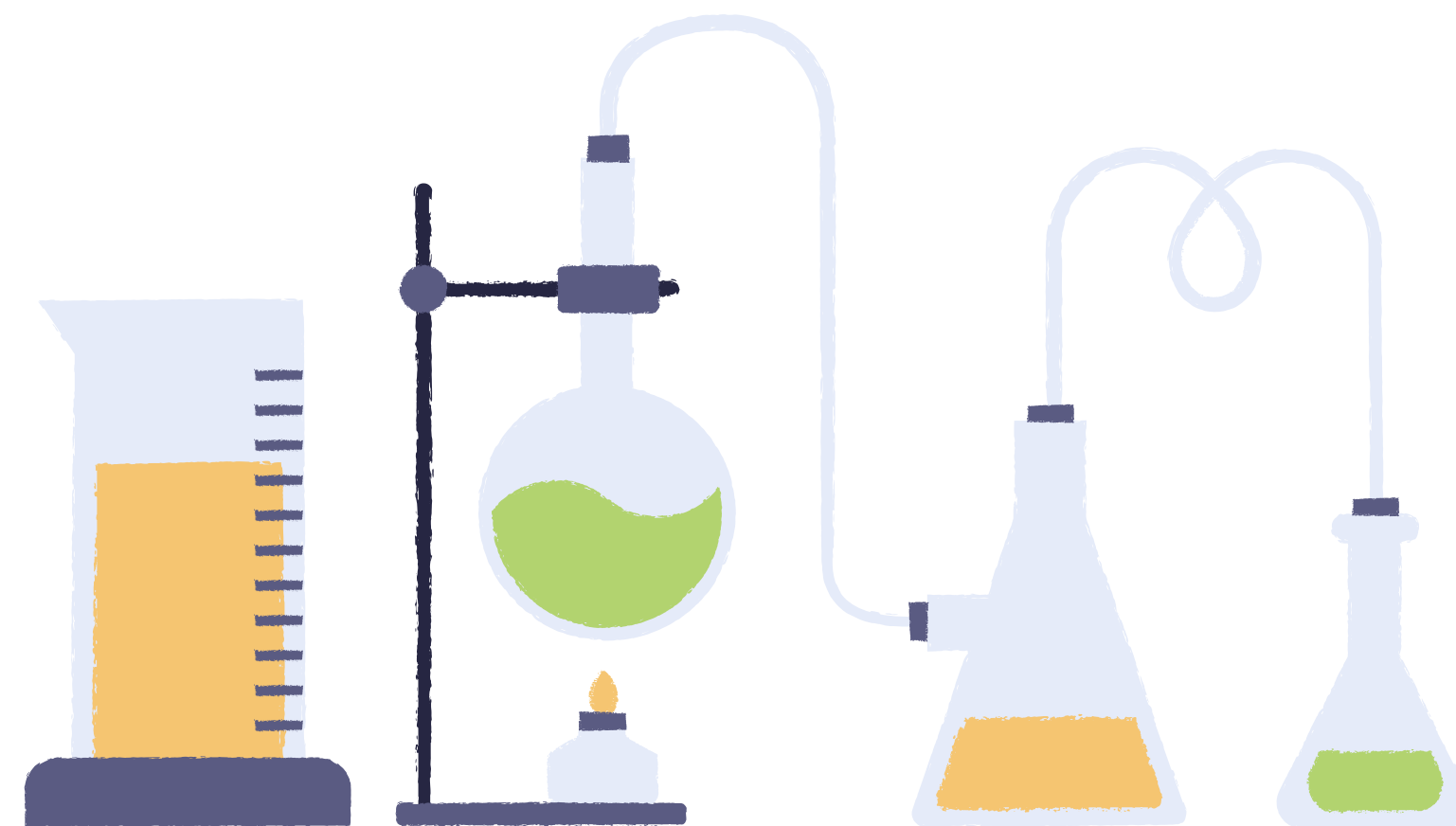
HELP has been offering the A Levels Programme for more than 30 years.

The average years of teaching experience for our lecturers is 19 years.



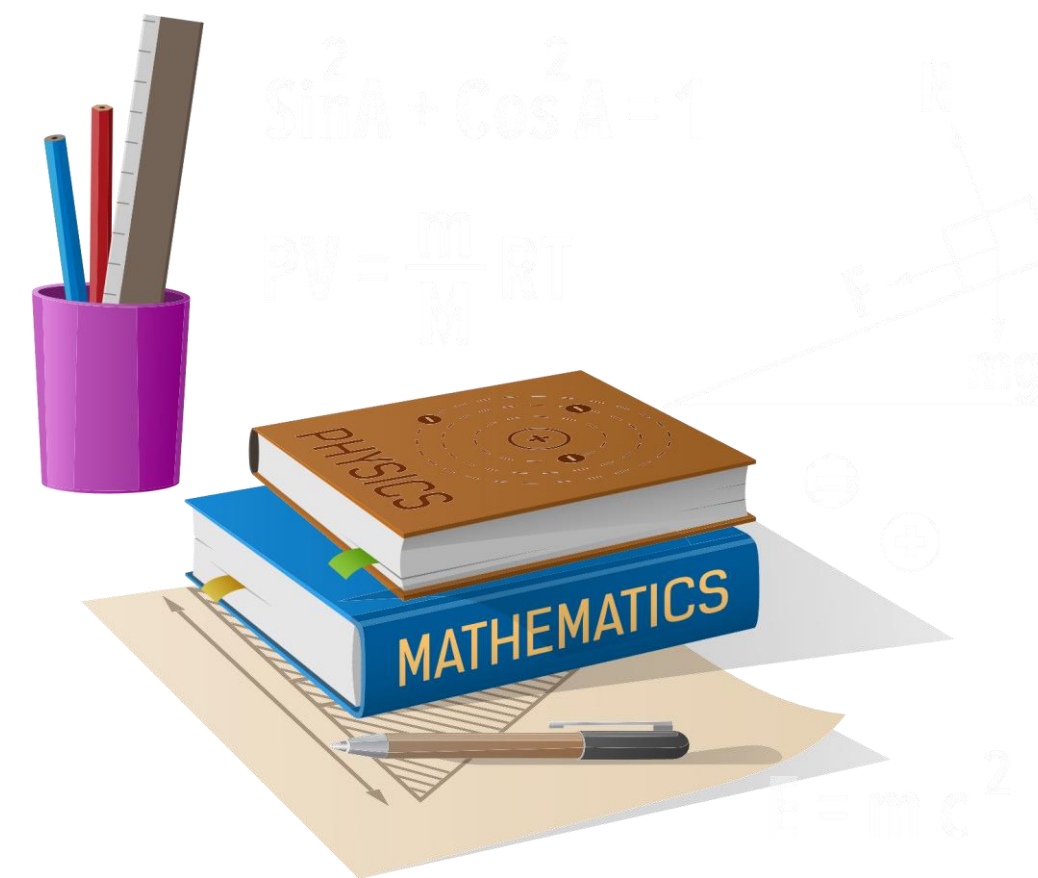

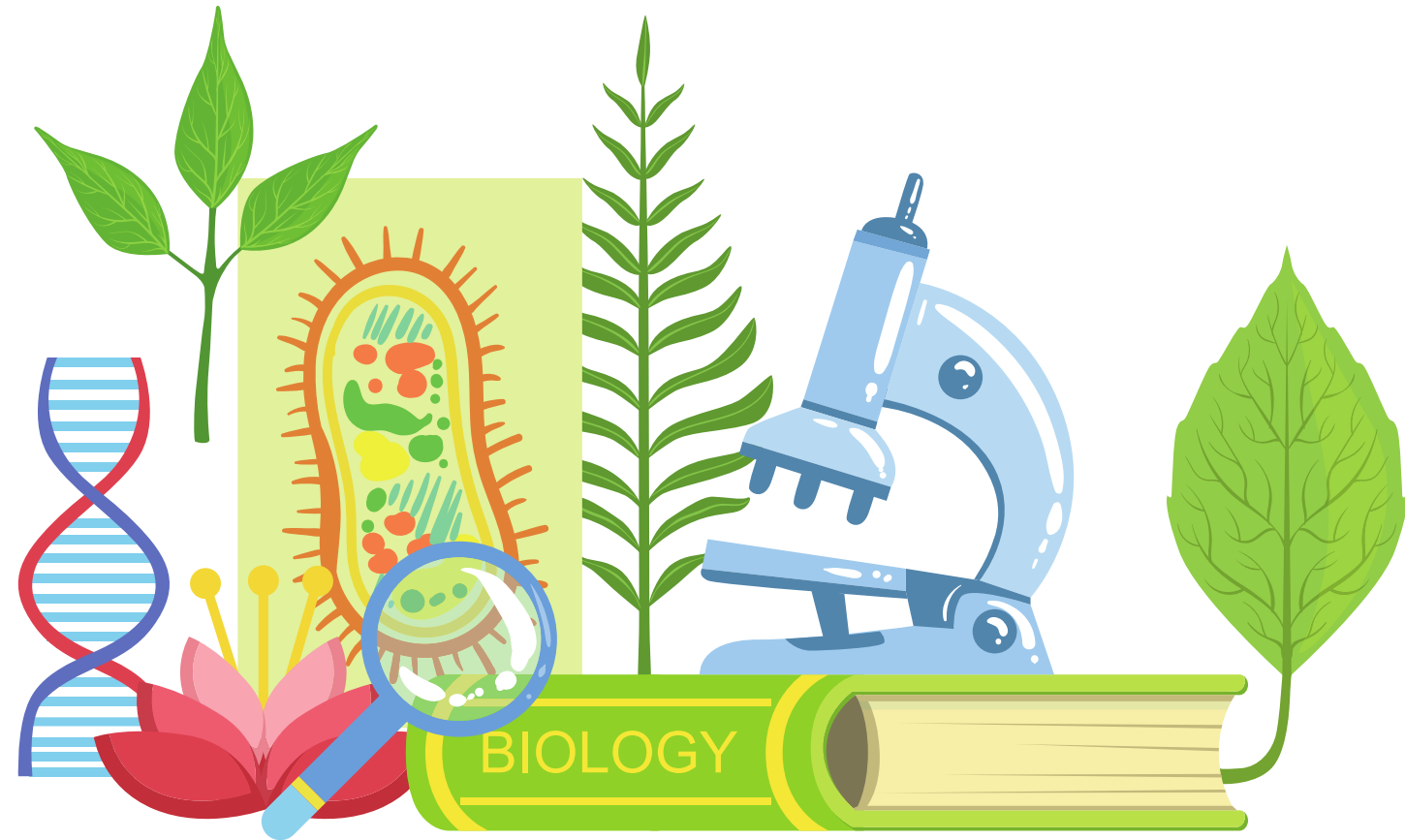

Students wanting to study Further Mathematics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Biology and Physics are strongly recommended to have studied the equivalent O Level subjects.

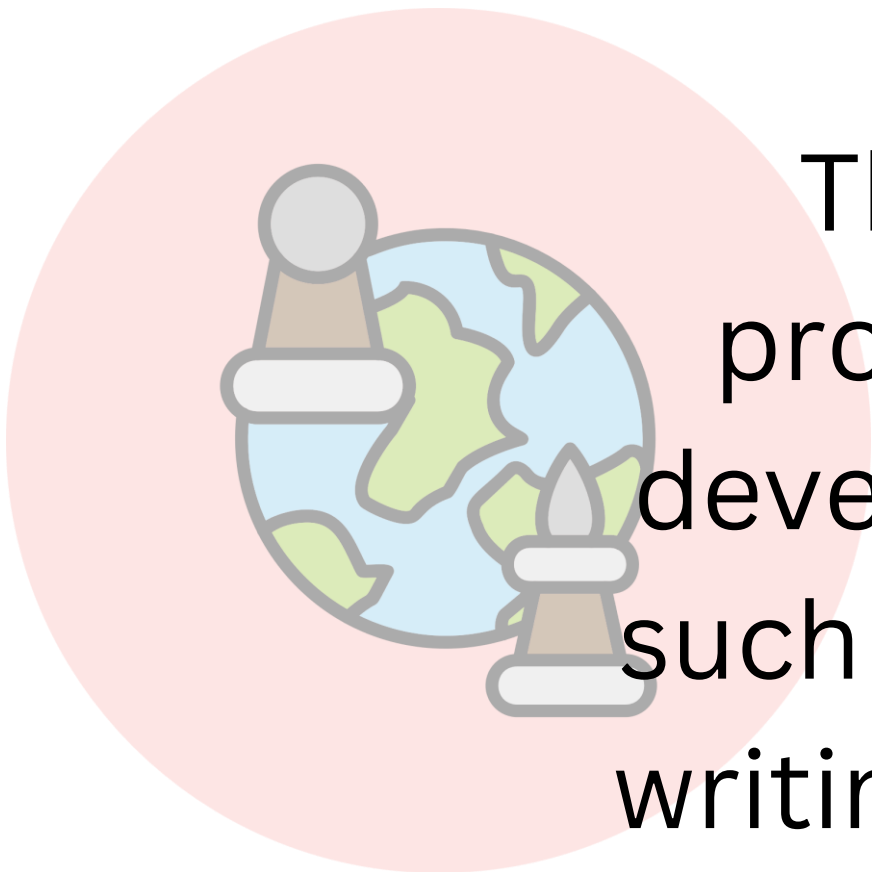

The majority of students from the Department of A Levels are headed for the United Kingdom.

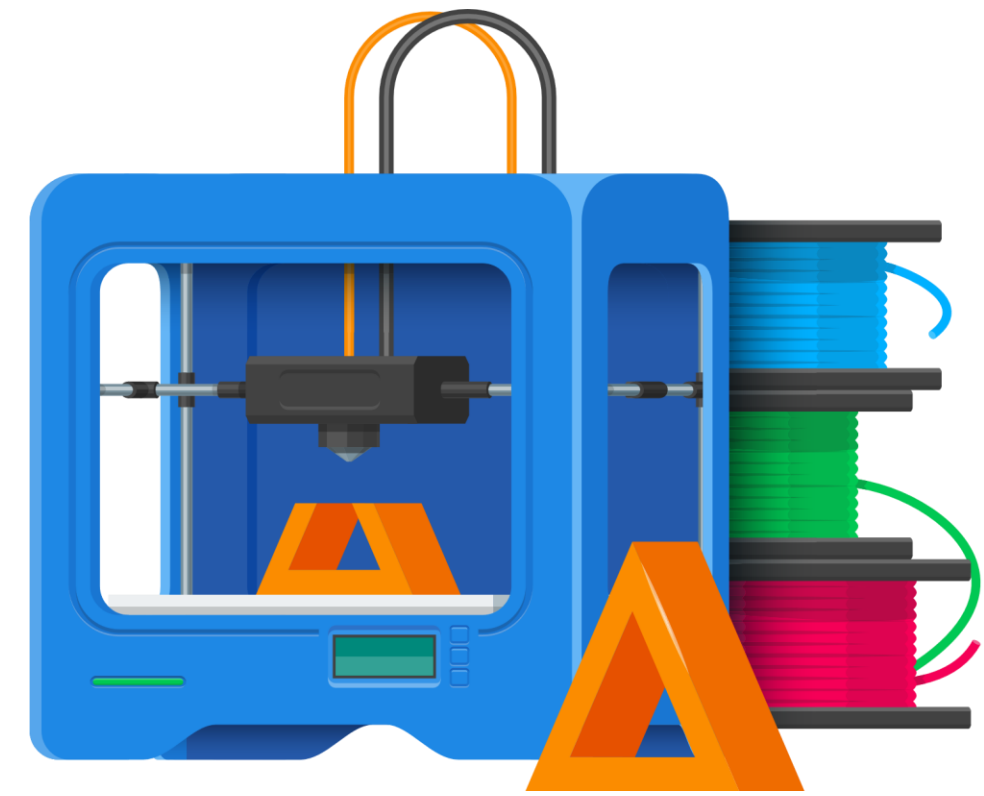
We have also sent students to the USA, Canada, Australia, South Korea, Germany, Hong Kong, Singapore, Japan and prestigious universities in other countries.

The A Levels qualification is accepted globally. The student only needs to fulfil the entry requirement for the relevant university and course.

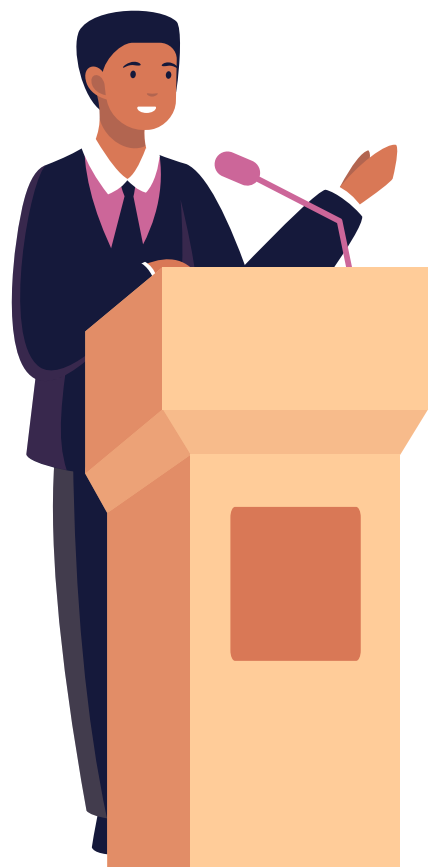
GETTING THE EDGE (GTE) PROGRAMME

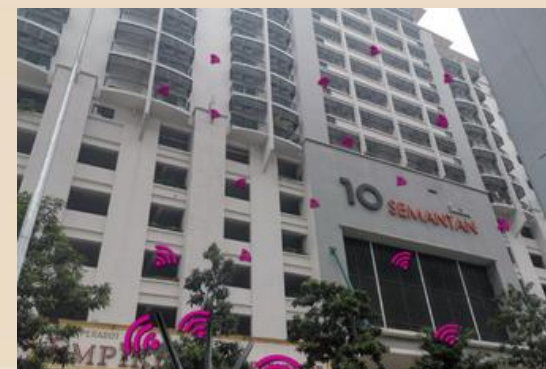

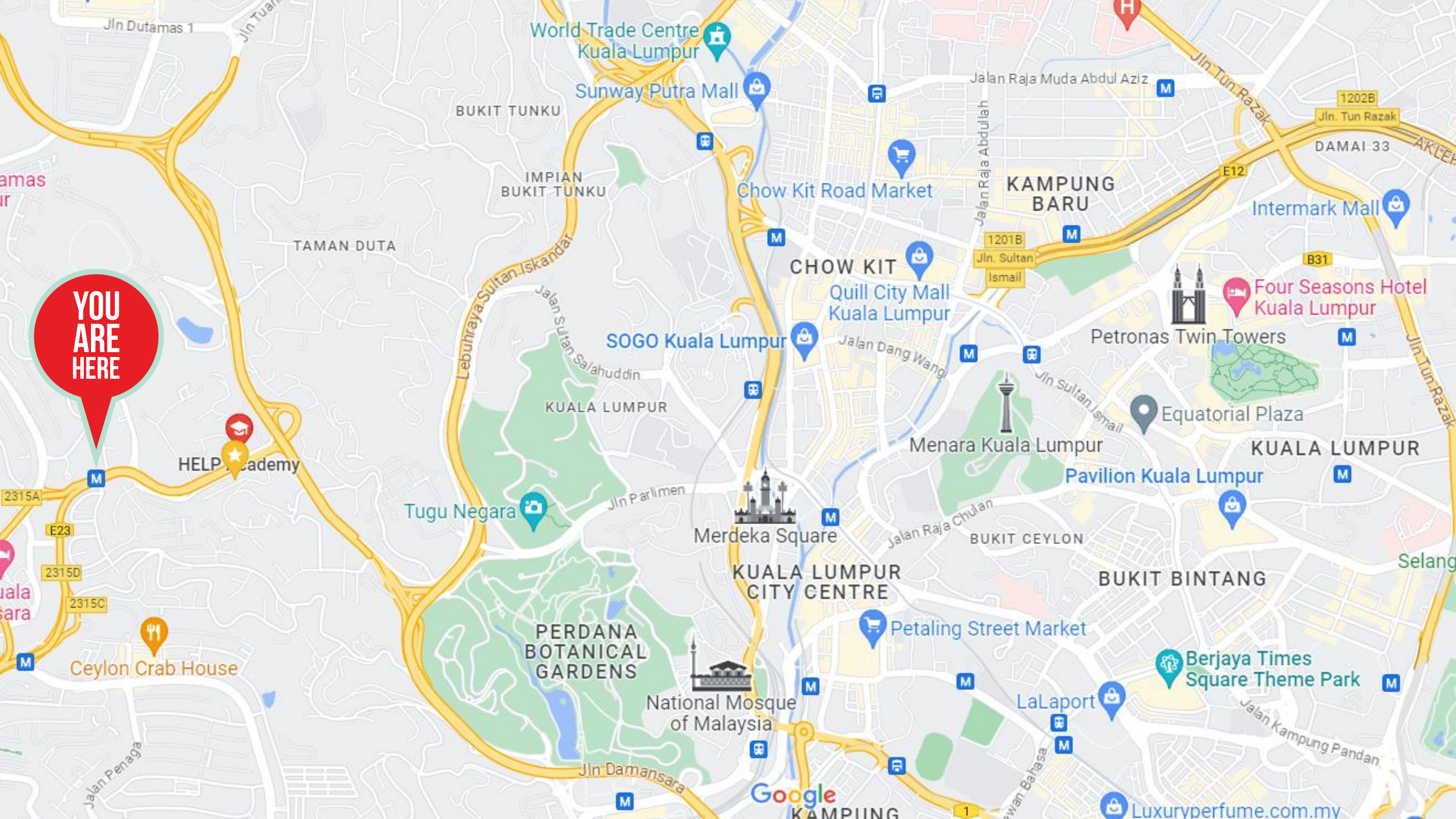
