


Our locations

Entry requirements

3-year undergraduate degree programmes

- a minimum of grades CCC in three A levels (or a minimum of 96 UCAS points)
- English Language and Mathematics GCSEs at grade C/grade 4 or above (or equivalent)

4-year undergraduate degree programmes

- at least one A level (or a minimum of 32 UCAS points)
- English Language GCSE at grade C/4 or above (or equivalent)



English Language Entry Requirements

- IELTS/IELTS Indicator 6 with a minimum of 5.5 in each component
- Pearson (PTE) minimum of 59 in each component (increase in requirement)
- TOEFL/TOEFL Home Edition Over all 72 R 18 W 17 S 20 L 17
- LanguageCert International ESOL Exam B2 L R W S 33 in each component
- Some programmes may require higher IELTS
- * Please refer to the offer letter for the English requirements.



Please note that applications for our Autumn 2020 term have now closed. Applications for our January and September 2021 intakes are still open.




