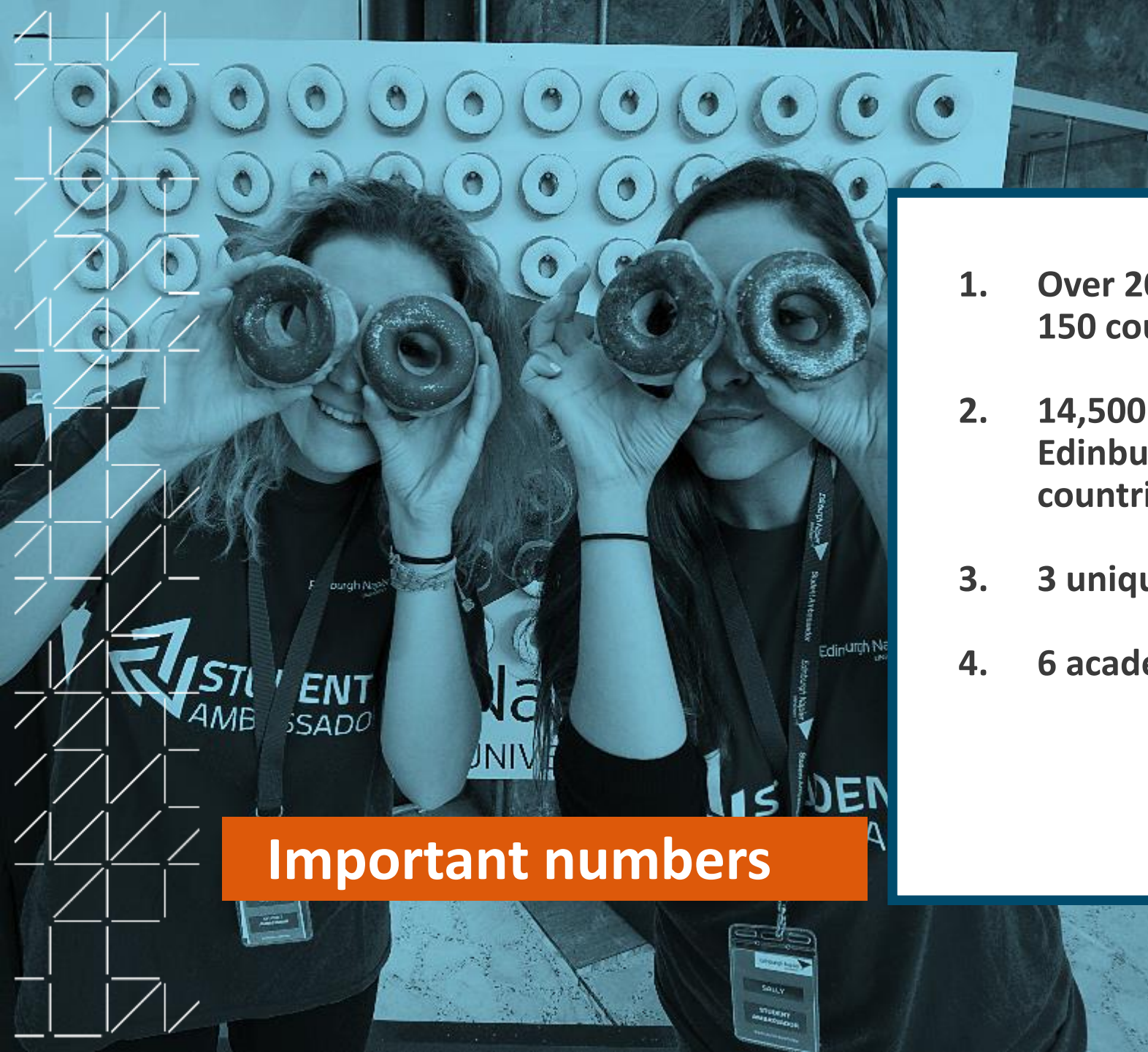

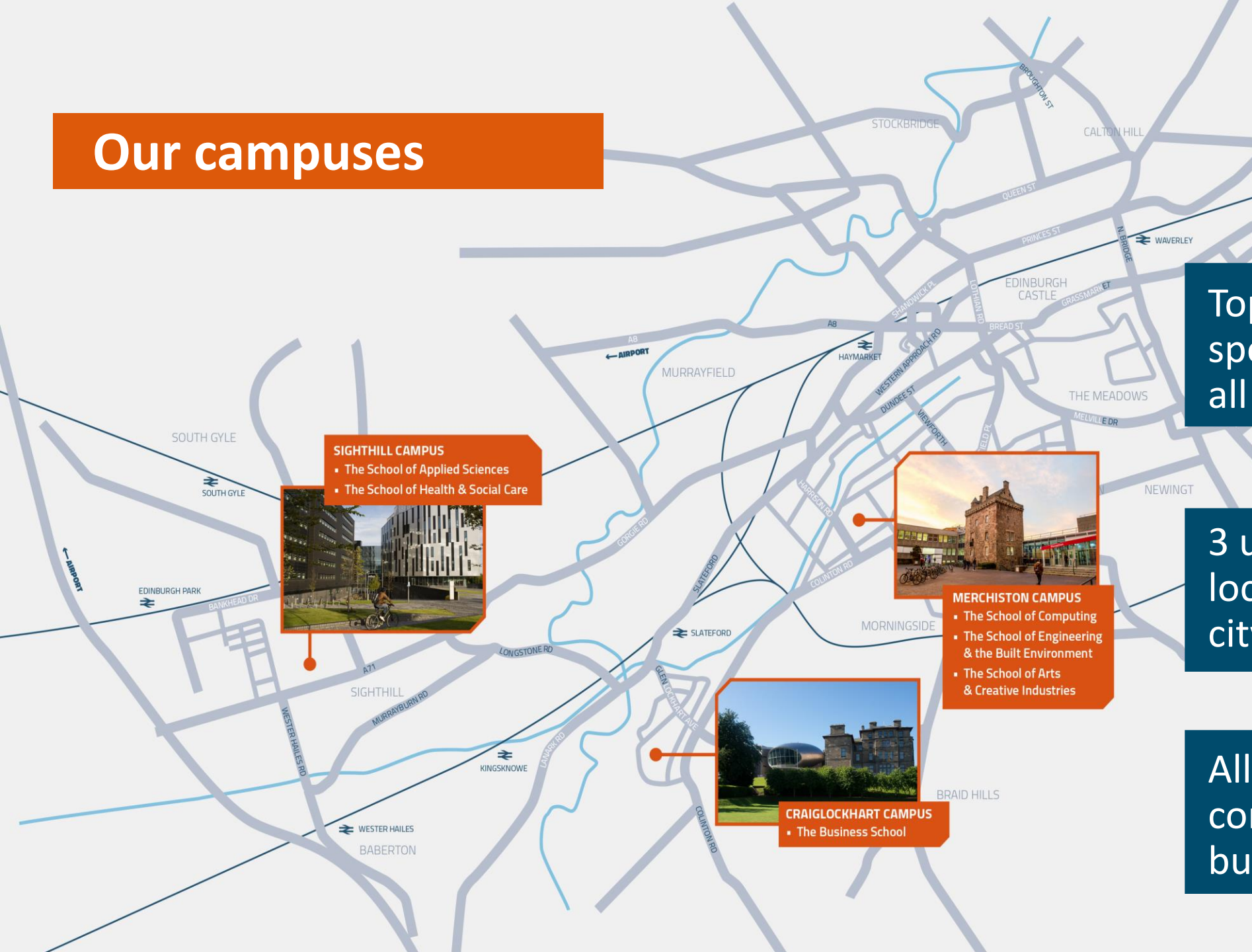

## Academic Requirements

For a Bachelors, we accept the Pearson's International A-level and International GCSE's. All Bachelor's programmes require 3 IA-levels. Some will have specific subject requirements, and some will have required IGCSE's. For example:

- BA(hons) Business Management – BCC at IA-level and C/4 in IGCSE English
- BEng(hons) Mechanical Engineering – CCC at IA-level including Maths and a Science and a C/4 in IGCSE English

For those who only have Pearson's IGCSE's,

We are in the process of confirming a partnership with a prominent pathway provider. Details will be announced soon

# English language requirements

## Accepted language tests

- **IELTS: 6.0 overall with no element below 5.5**
- **TOEFL: 80 overall** (minimum 17 in listening, 18 in reading, 20 in speaking and 17 in writing)
- **Pearson's: 56 overall with minimum of 51 in each component**





## **Tuition fees**

**Undergraduate fees for September 2022:  
£14,170-£16,425 per year**

## **ASEAN Scholarship**

- **Worth £3,000**
- **Available for the first year of a UG course**
- **Limited number, first-come first-served**
