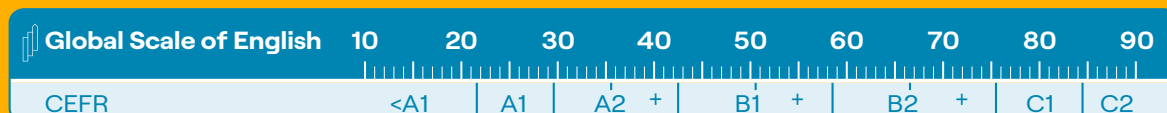
Now aligned with the Canadian Language Benchmarks

Pearson developed the **Global Scale of English (GSE)** to provide instructors and learners with a more granular understanding of English language proficiency. It has been designed to build learners' confidence by revealing exactly where they are on their learning journey and setting personalized goals to help them progress. The GSE is an ecosystem that underpins the Pearson English Journey:

- ★ **GSE Scale:** a proficiency scale from 10 to 90, with clear statements for what a learner can achieve in speaking, listening, reading, and writing at any point on the scale.
- ★ **GSE Learning Objectives:** descriptions of what learners can do at each level of proficiency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing.
- ★ **Courseware:** all of Pearson's English Language Learning courseware is developed using the GSE Learning Objectives.
- ★ **Assessment:** institutions can develop their own assessment materials using the GSE Learning Objectives and assessment frameworks or choose one of Pearson's digital assessments which reports on the GSE.

The **GSE** is the result of many years of research with **more than 6,000 teachers from over 50 countries**. It serves as a standard against which English language courses and assessments worldwide can be benchmarked.

The **GSE** has been psychometrically aligned to the Common European Framework of Reference or **CEFR** (see De Jong, Mayor, & Hayes, 2016). It complements and extends the **CEFR** by adding an extra layer of detail to the **CEFR** levels and providing thousands of additional learning objectives. This extra information helps learners understand where they are now and offers a step-by-step guide to where they want to go next. Using the **GSE**, teachers can match a student to course materials to suit their exact level and learning goals.



About Canadian Language Benchmarks

The Global Scale of English and the Canadian Language Benchmarks have been integrated to provide a more holistic evaluation of English language proficiency.

This alignment aims to assist institutions in accurately assessing the English language skills of immigrants and other individuals aspiring to reside or work in Canada.

Alignment Methodology and Results

Each Canadian Language Benchmark competency statement within each competency area was aligned to one or more GSE Learning Objectives. The profile of ability, sample indicators of ability and sample tasks were also consulted during the alignment. Given that the target audience for the CLBs is adult learners, GSE Learning Objectives for Adults, Professionals and Academic were used.

The results of the GSE alignment show consistency with the CEFR-CLB alignment carried out by North and Piccardo in 2018.
