The program comes in **two versions** to meet different school needs:

- **Blue Version:** Adapted for schools focused on core lessons and lighter exposure (1–2 hours/week).
- **Red Version:** Full curriculum for bilingual and schools with intensive English exposure (5–8 hours/week).

Both versions share the same engaging characters, inquiry-based approach, and integrated print and digital resources.

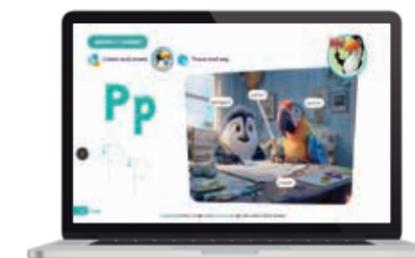
