On the bus, we should *offer our seat to people who need it*. We shouldn't *put our feet on the seat opposite*. It is selfish.



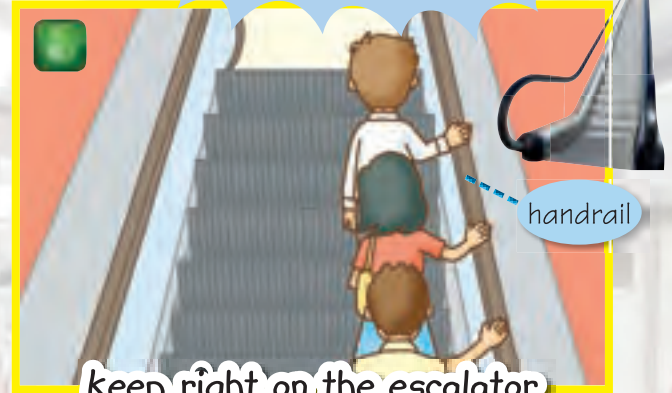
jump the queue

Please hold the handrail.



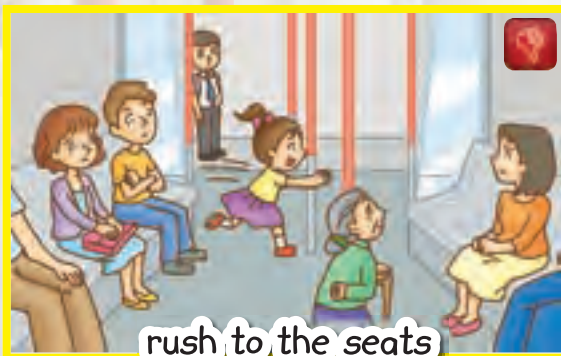
keep right on the escalator

How to behave at the theatre

A theatre is a place where you can watch performances such as plays, ballets and musicals. How should you behave when you are at the theatre?

First of all, it is very important to arrive on time. If you arrive late, you should stand at the back and wait. You should only go to your seat when there is a break in the performance.

While you are watching the performance, you should sit properly. You should stay in your seat until intermission. This way you will not disturb other people in the audience. You should not eat or drink in the theatre but you can have refreshments outside the theatre during the intermission.

At the end of the performance, there is a curtain call. This is when the performers come on stage and the audience applauds. When the curtain call finishes, you can leave the theatre.

The next time you go to a theatre, remember the above tips and you will be a good audience member!
