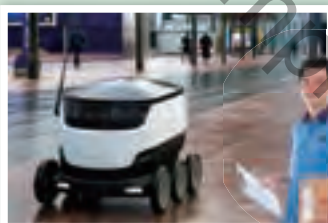

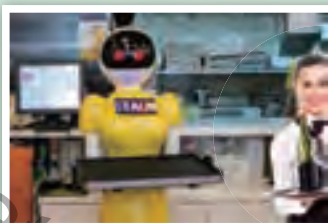

Robots

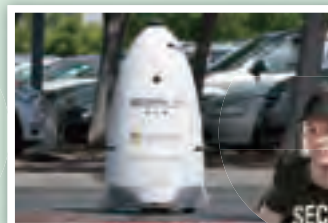
Robots are smart enough to do a lot of jobs, especially those that don't require a lot of decision-making.



A delivery robot



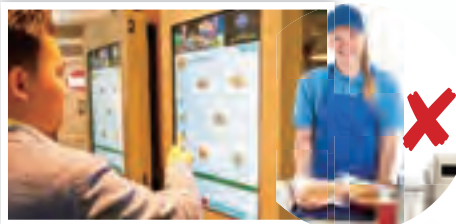

at a fast food shop



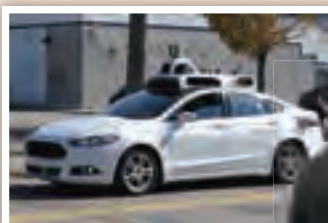
A self-service check-in kiosk
