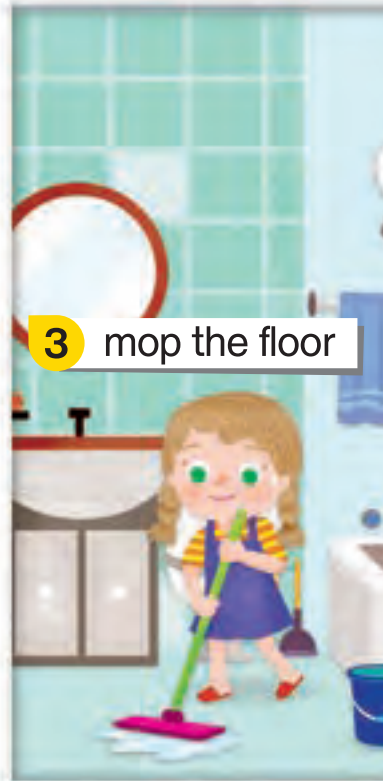

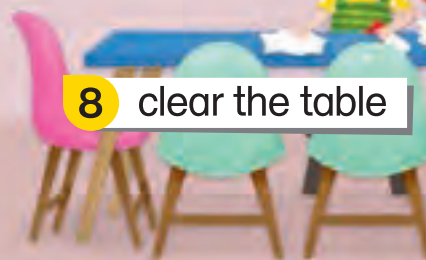

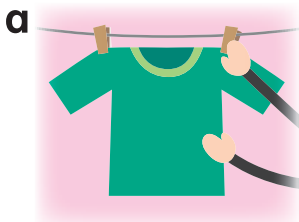
FM : Do the seven dwarfs help at home?

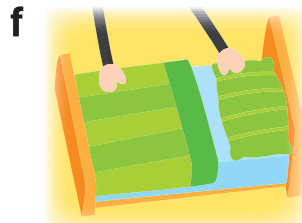


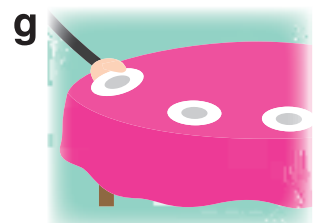

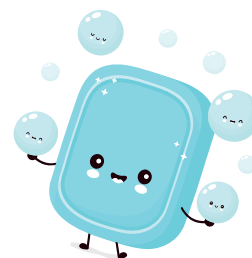
