Smarthinking tutors do not provide answers.

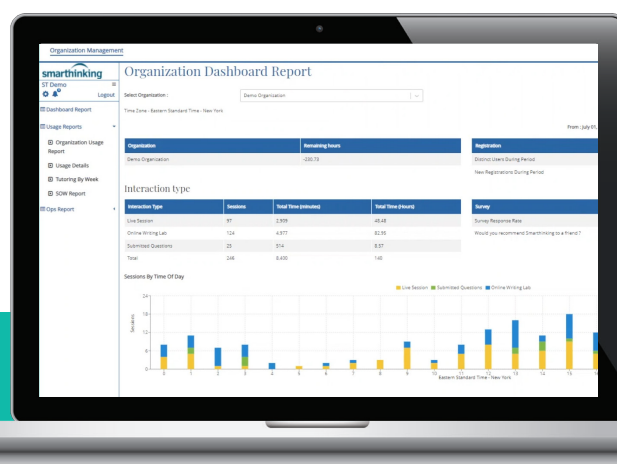

Wide range of easy-to-access services

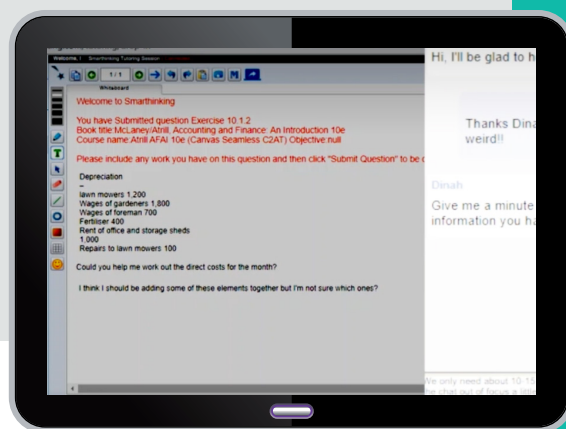
Smarthinking is user-friendly and easily accessible through your VLE via mobiles, tablets or laptops. You can choose to give your students access to some or all of the services available, including:

- Connect with a tutor for on-demand feedback via a live tutoring session
- Submit writing for review
- Ask a subject-specific question
- Engage in a group session
- Careers support (CV and cover letter writing, coaching and interview preparation).

How do tutors interact with students?

During live sessions, tutors use a virtual whiteboard to work through problems with students online and focus on expanding student's understanding of good writing techniques.

Students can even work together outside of class in Smarthinking's group tutoring sessions and can invite a Smarthinking tutor to join the discussion if they need extra help.



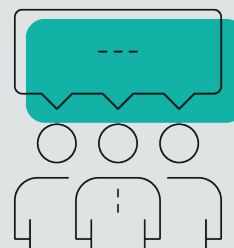

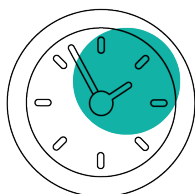
Could 24/7 academic writing support help your students stay the course?



Research¹ shows that, even before the pandemic, **36% of students lacked confidence in asking for support**. In addition, **30%** lacked faith in their ability to be able to identify potential problems with their written assignments. So how can universities support students who **feel unable** to make use of existing in-house support yet are struggling with confidence in their writing capabilities?
