# Why try online tutoring?

Bramble, the UK's leading online tutoring platform spoke to over 2,200 teachers, tutors, and students in July 2022 to get their thoughts on online tutoring. The results are in – online tutoring is effective and here to stay!

With a shift toward digital teaching and learning during the pandemic, many questioned the viability of this method of reaching students. Following this year's survey, 97% of tutors plan on continuing with online tutoring with 51% tutoring exclusively online. The survey also showed that 84% of tutors and 87% of students find one-to-one and small group online tutoring just as effective or even more effective than in-person sessions.

Searchable lesson recordings, which can be used to support revision but also keep tutors




Of all those questioned in 2021, **61%** found Bramble to be the most effective online platform, followed by Zoom at **16%** and Microsoft Teams at **10%**.


