- Gertrude Elion was born in 1918 in New York.



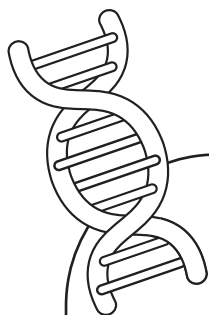
