Use the example to work out the codes below

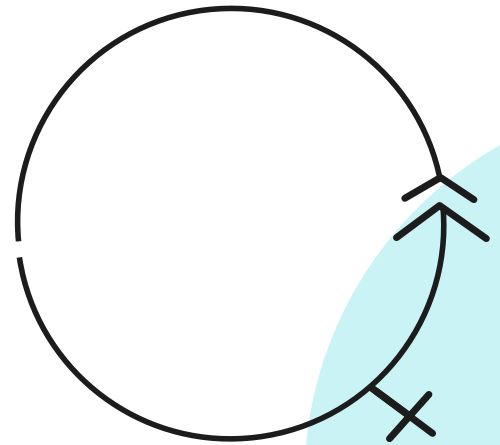
**Q1)** 6 8 25 15 13 15 55 25 = **Feminism**

Use the space below to work out which numbers represent each letter, the letter A has been done for you.

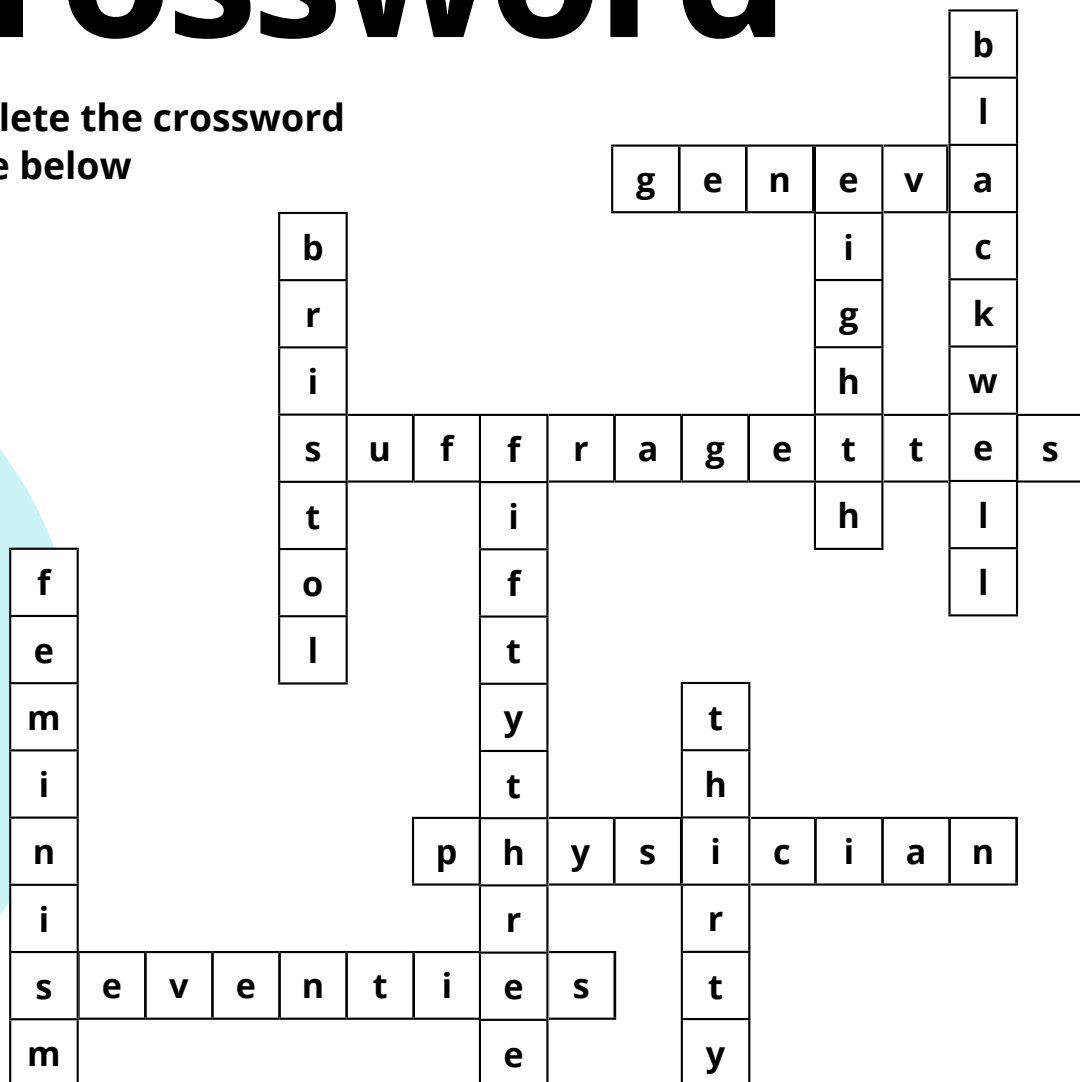
