THE PEARSON TQ PROGRAMME

All Royal Engineer Apprentices complete defined phases of training and by liaising with key-stakeholders Pearson TQ has been able to develop a delivery programme that utilises these phases to ensure an efficient Apprenticeship completion.

Phase 1 – Basic training.

Phase 2a – Combat Engineer. In this phase the Apprentice starts their Army Apprenticeship and completes the required English and Maths Functional Skills for their trade. The learning is delivered within a dedicated education week at Pearson TQ’s on-site Learning Centre.



Phase 2b – Trade training at the Royal School of Military Engineering. The mandatory military trade training course is mapped to the Apprenticeship requirements allowing the Apprentice to evidence the required trade skills and knowledge within this phase. In addition, Pearson TQ delivers any required ICT Functional Skills, Employee Rights and Responsibilities (ERR) and Personal Learning & Thinking Skills (PLTS) within this phase.

Phase 3 – Field Army and progression to higher level courses. Pearson TQ supports the Army Apprentice to embed and evidence the skills gained at RSME while completing work in the Field Army and on deployments in the UK and abroad.

MEASURING SUCCESS

The Corps of Royal Engineers has approximately 10,000 staff situated globally, and of these around **700** successfully undertake an Apprenticeship with Pearson TQ each year.

Pearson TQ consistently delivers outstanding learning outcomes and exceeds national benchmarks in Apprenticeship achievement.



We have currently attained an **overall success rate of 87%** and a **timely success rate of 85%** for all Army Apprenticeships with the Corps of Royal Engineers.
