Reading and Interpreting Data Displays

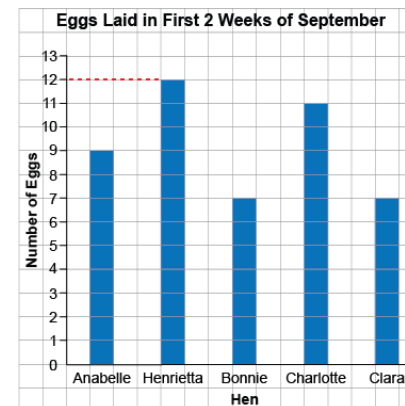
Notices the basic shape of graph

Counts symbols or squares to read data

"1, 2, 3, ..., 10, 11, 12 squares are shaded.
Henrietta laid 12 eggs."

Uses scale to read data

"The bar has height 12. Henrietta laid
12 eggs."

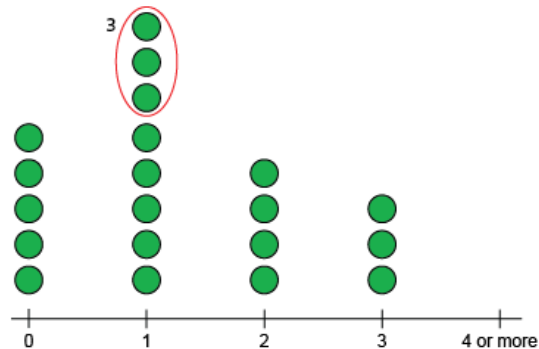
Interpreting Bar Graphs

Makes direct comparisons between data

"1 squirrel was seen 3 more times than 0 squirrels."

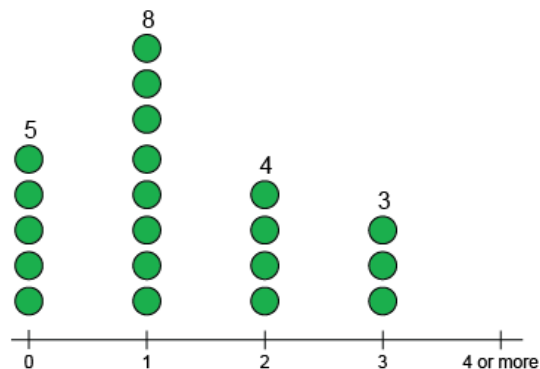
Squirrels Seen in One Hour (Winter)



Uses data to answer some questions

" $5 + 8 + 4 + 3 = 20$; 20 students were surveyed."

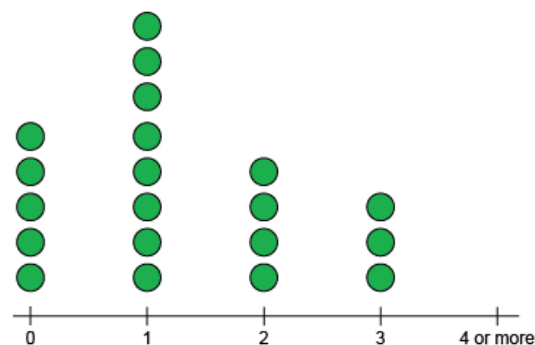
Squirrels Seen in One Hour (Winter)



Draws conclusions from data

"Most students saw 1 squirrel in one hour in the winter."
