- 1 **2•13** You have just arrived in a town and you don't know your way around. You talk to a woman at a bus stop.
- ◆ Say *excuse me* and ask if there is a tourist office in the area.
  - **Sí, a 200 metros, a la derecha.**
  - ◆ Repeat the directions and ask her where the bank is.
  - **A 100 metros, pero ahora está cerrado.**
  - ◆ Ask the woman what time it opens.
  - **A las 9.30 de la mañana.**
  - ◆ Ask her what time it closes.
  - **A la 1.30.**
  - ◆ Thank her and say goodbye.
