4. A suggested sequence for a writing lesson


Below is a suggested lesson sequence. It links closely to the teaching approaches for teaching writing and the writing process (Chapter 1).

This lesson sequence has three parts:

- 1. lesson introduction
- 2. independent writing (including the teacher's role)
- 3. lesson wrap-up.

1. Lesson introduction (usually whole class)

- Motivate the students for the writing task.
- Agree on and unpack the criteria for the lesson.
- Teach modelled and shared writing to demonstrate and practise the criteria.
- Step and check: use the 'think, pair, share' strategy to check that all students understand, and practise the criteria for the lesson.
