The Cooper's Concert on Thursday at Stony River was very disappointing.

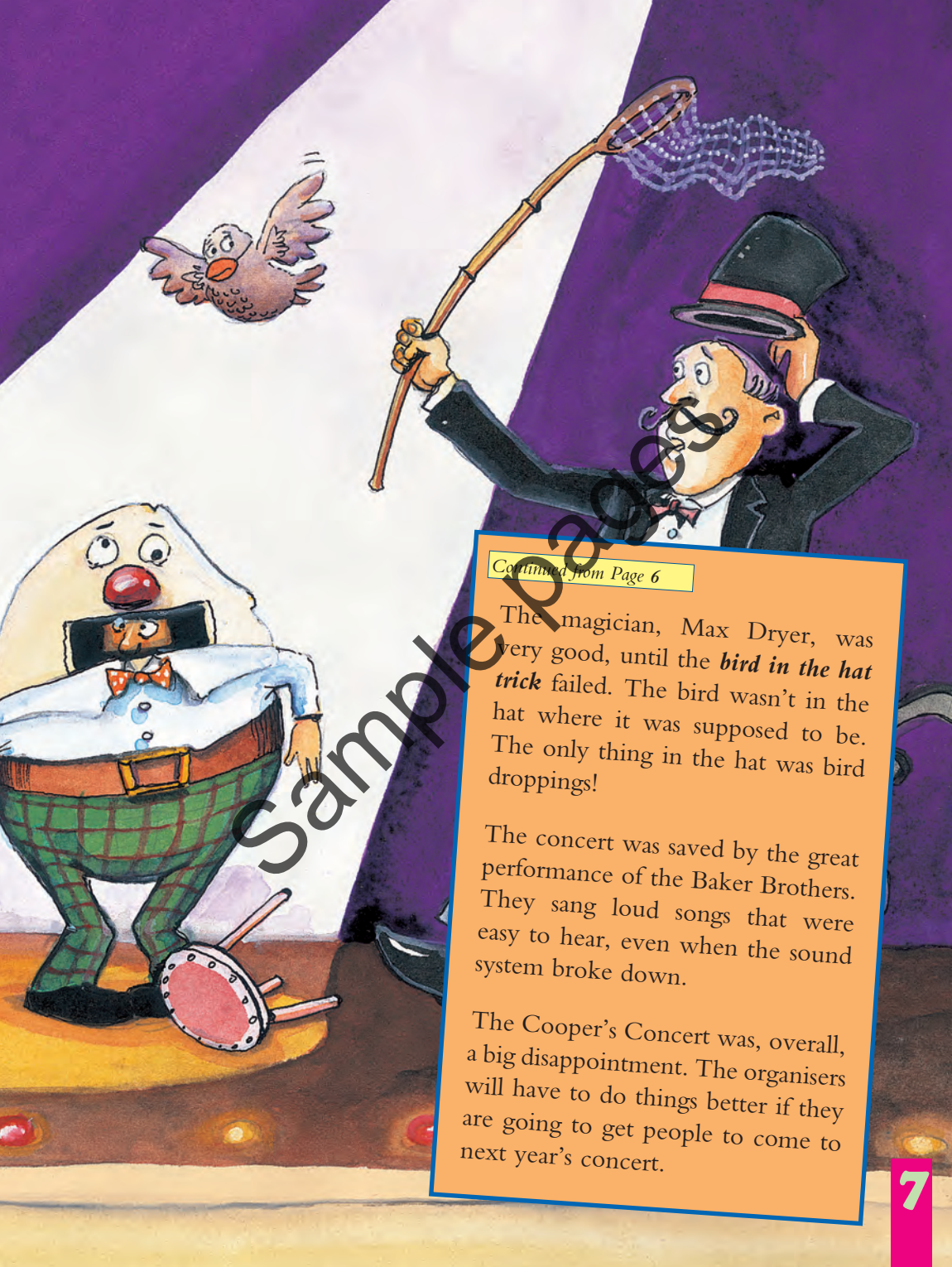
The lights for the stage kept flicking off and on. They flicked off just as the Humpty Dumpties came on stage. One of them fell over a stool and made a big dent in his costume.
