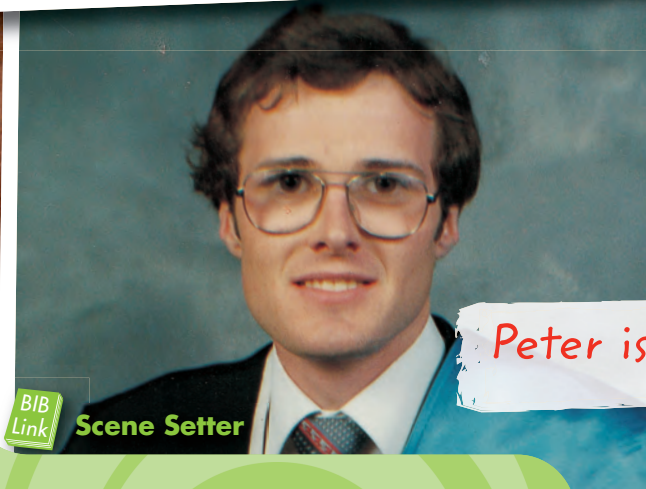
When my sister Kate and I visit Grandma, we like to look at her photo album.

are our cousins.

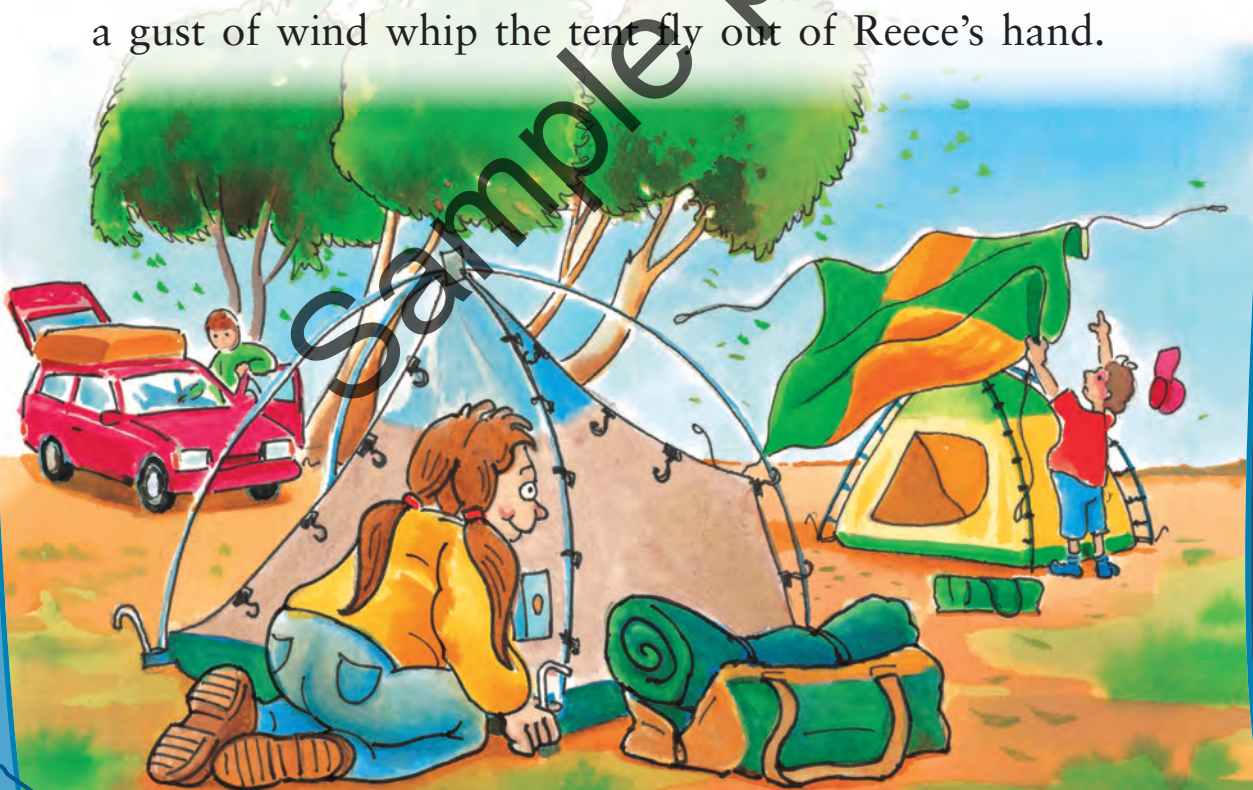


A Family Camping Trip
