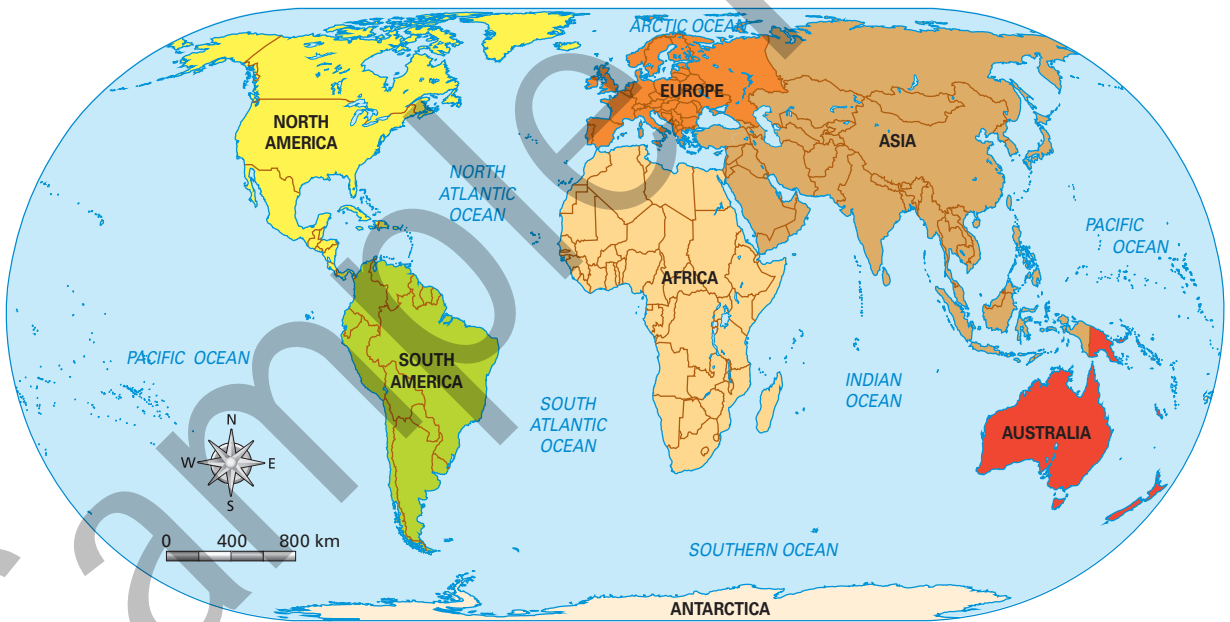


Continents
