
How to use **ActiveLearn Primary**


Logging in to ActiveLearn Primary

Completing Bug Club e-books

Bug Club e-books have little 'quizzes' for children to complete as they read through the book. These are shown by a bug head in a circle which will appear on some pages of the book. Once every quiz has been done, the book is complete!

Completing Abacus maths games

Each **Abacus practice game** has three levels: Bronze, Silver and Gold. This will give your child a great sense of achievement as they master each level. They will need to get most of the questions right in order to get to the next level. Once they have mastered Gold, the game is complete!
