Introduction: Understanding the New BTEC Tech Awards


- Level 1 and level 2 qualifications designed for Key Stage 4 students in schools in England and Northern Ireland to study alongside GCSEs.
- They're the same size as a single GCSE.
- Their aim: to give students a taste of what a sector is like, and the skills and confidence to take their next steps.
- Designed to meet the DfE's guidance for Key Stage 4 performance measures in England to count in the 'Open Group' (non-EBacc category) of Progress 8.



Introduction: Understanding the New BTEC Tech Awards

BTEC Tech Awards give students the chance discover their aptitude for a career in a particular sector and develop essential knowledge and skills.

Every BTEC Tech Award has the same three components:





These components build on each other to motivate your students by helping them put what they've learned into practice and grow in confidence.

Introduction: Understanding BTEC Tech Award Results

Data definitions

The results publication for the BTEC Tech Awards only reports outcomes for completed qualifications. This is different from the data rules used for the BTEC Firsts, where results are reported based on projected completions. This means these results for the BTEC Tech Awards refer to those people claiming this academic year rather than being dependent on a projected length of course.

What is a completion? - In these results, a completion refers to qualifications where a learner has been awarded a grade for the qualification, which can include U (unclassified).

What is a Pass? – These results also show figures for learners who have passed the qualification (achieved a Pass grade or above). Learners who have completed but not passed are awarded U. To pass, learners must have completed the qualification, passed the externally assessed units and achieved the required number of points on the qualification as a whole.

Rounding

Numbers in these slides are generally rounded to the nearest multiple of 100. Smaller numbers may be rounded to the nearest 10.


2018/19 was the first year of certification for five specifications for the BTEC Tech Awards.

The remaining six specifications, which include Sport, Child Development and Travel & Tourism, will see their first completions in 2019/20.

Outcomes by region



The West Midlands has the highest number of learners completing the new Tech Awards in 2018-19, closely followed by Yorkshire and the Humber.


2018-19 is the first year for these qualifications, with 2019-20 being the first year for the remaining specifications, so the picture we see in future years could be quite different.

BTEC Tech Awards: 2018/19 five sectors by volume and gender

Learners taking Health and Social Care and Performing Arts are more likely to be female, while learners taking Engineering and Enterprise are more likely to be male.

BTEC Tech Awards achievement: grades explained

Learners who pass the BTEC Tech Awards are awarded grades using the range from Level 1 Pass (L1P), the lowest qualifying grade, up to Level 2 Distinction Star (L2D*), the highest.

Learners who have not met the standard for a Level 1 Pass are graded U (Unclassified).

These figures include the first cohort of learners completing these qualifications over two years.

Grades at pass and above for these qualification suite are awarded as a single grade which also indicates whether the grade is at Level 1 or Level 2, e.g. L1D.

This is the first year of qualification level results for the BTEC Tech Awards in Health and Social Care, Performing Arts, Creative Media Production, Engineering and Enterprise. The volume of learners varies across sectors. Outcomes also vary across sectors. Like GCSEs, results are not expected to look similar across different subject areas.
